Pursuant to the provisions of Section 47 CFR 0.459 and 0.457 Zonar Systems requests short-term confidentiality for documents filed under the following exhibit types

Short term confidentiality release date: *180 days from grant issue date*

These items contain detailed system and equipment description and related information about the product which *Zonar Systems* considers to be proprietary, confidential and a custom design which otherwise would not be released to the general public. Since this design is a basis from which future technological products will evolve, *Zonar Systems* also feels that this information would be of benefit to its competitors, and that the disclosure of the information in these exhibits would give our competitors an unfair advantage in the market.
