2. Charging Your Headset

- The Headsets and Charging Cradle come with built-in rechargeable batteries. Prior to using the headsets and Charging Cradle for the first time, it is recommended to fully charge the batteries.
- Charge the Headsets

 Put both Right and Left headsets into the supplied
- Charging Cradle. Fully charging the headsets takes around 2 hours.
 The red indicator will turn on during charging.
 When the batteries are fully charged, the red indicator
- Charge the Charging Cradle Connect the USB cable to the micro USB port of the Charging Cradle.
- Fully charging the Charging Cradle takes around 2 hours.
 The red indicator will turn on during charging.
- When the Charging Cradle is fully charged, the red indicator light will turn off. Disconnect the cable from the Cradle.
 NOTE:
- The fully charged headsets bring up to 2 hours of music playing time, and 40 hours of standby time. The Charging Cradle can provide 4 times extra recharges for the headsets. Use only the supplied charger / USB charging cable to

3. Pairing Your Headset with a Bluetooth Device

) Ensure both headsets are off.

2) To activate the pairing mode, press and hold the MFBs of both Right and Left headsets for 8 seconds without releasing your fingers until their status indicators flash blue and red alternately. 3) Right and Left headsets will pair each other in around 10 seconds. 4) Once the headset pairing was successful, the headsets will be

ready to pair with phone. 5) Activate your mobile phone's Bluetooth, search Bluetooth devices, select "TOSCAZERO" and enter the passcode "0000". When the pairing is completed, the headsets' status indicators will flash blue every 5 seconds.

If the Right and Left headset pairing is not completed within 2 minutes, the headset will turn to standby mode. If this happens, please turn off the headsets and repeat the pairing steps.
