PAIRING

Your device must have Bluetooth® capability. Turn off any devices that may have been previously paired to the speakers.

1. Press and hold the power button to turn speaker on. You will hear a beep.
2. Place your device within 3 ft.
3. Enable Bluetooth® on your device and search for new Bluetooth® devices. Refer to your device's manual on how to enable and operate Bluetooth®.
4. Select BIKE SPEAKER from the list of Bluetooth® available devices.
5. A beep from the speakers will notify you when the speaker is successfully paired.
6. You can now stream music wirelessly from your device to your speakers.

Note: If you restart the speaker it will automatically pair with your device. A beep will notify you when the speaker is successfully paired.

CHARGING

1. Remove USB protector cover.
2. Attach the small part of the USB charging cable to the speaker.
3. Attach the other portion of the cable to a computer's USB port.
4. A red light will turn on, indicating speakers are charging.
5. Remove the USB cable from computer when the red LED light turns off.
6. Close with USB protector cover.

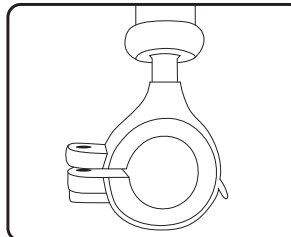
Note: It takes approximately 1 hour to fully charge speakers.

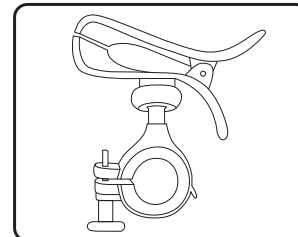

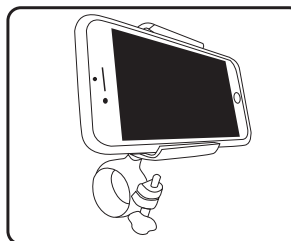
MOUNTING



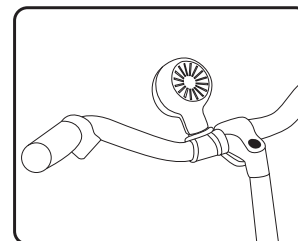
1. Remove screw then add grips according to the thickness of your handle bar.



2. Position the mount then lock it into place.



3. Add your phone to the mount once the mount is fully secure.



4. Mount the speaker by looping it around the handle bar.
