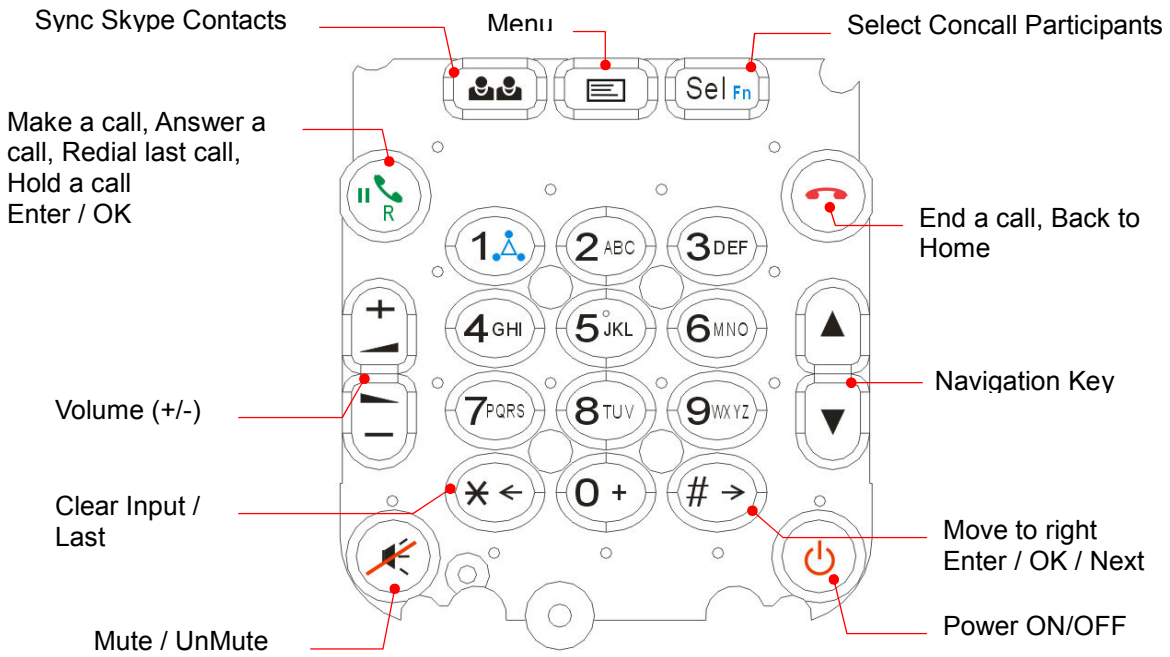

Getting Started

Minimum System Requirements

- PC running Windows XP, 2000
- Skype software installed
- At least 600 MHz processor
- At least 128 MB RAM
- At least 50MB free disk space on your hard drive
- CD-ROM drive

Setting up the Conference Phone kit

1. Connect USB cable to charge battery pack (please let the battery charge for a full 6 hours before using the phone for the first time)

Software / Driver Installation

If you have any Bluetooth driver (software) previously installed on your computer or built-in bluetooth device, please remove the driver and disable Bluetooth device first!

1. Please insert the Utility & Driver CD into CD-ROM drive, and then follow the instruction below to install Utility and drivers.

Note: DO NOT connect the BUB-211C USB adapter until instructed to do so.

Note: If the setup menu does not launch automatically, use Windows Explorer to navigate to the appropriate CD-ROM drive and run "Setup"

1. Insert the **Utility & Driver CD ROM** into your computer's CD-ROM Drive and then click **Install Driver/Utility**.

2. Please click **Next**.

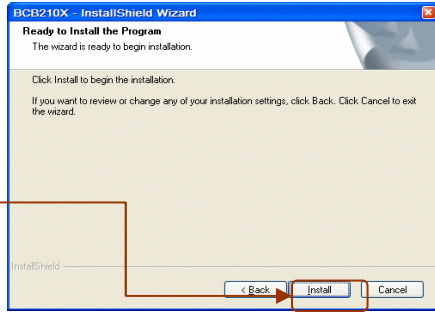
3. Please click **Next**.

4. When you reach this screen, please select **Yes, I do**. Click **Next**.

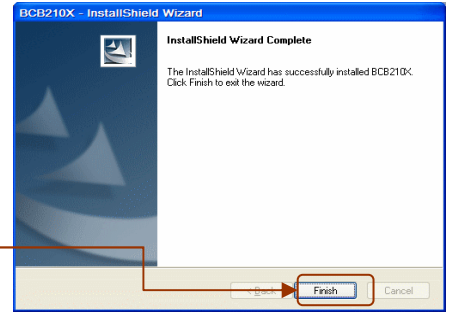

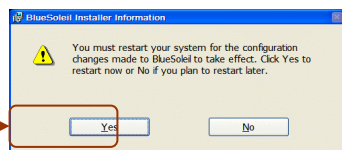


14. Disregard all popup Windows except for the installation Window shown to the right and click **Finish**

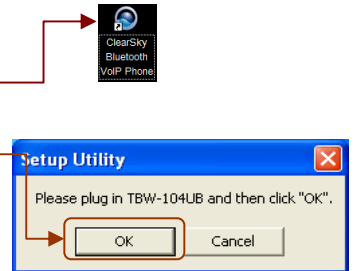

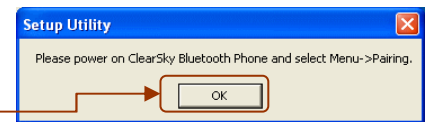


17. Click **Search**.

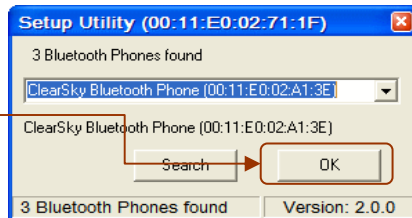

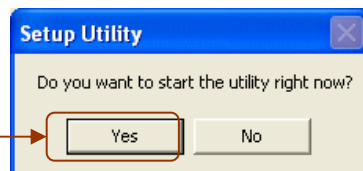
19. Select your Bluetooth Phone (Please check the MAC address to select the right device. Please remove the battery to locate the MAC address label). Click **OK**.



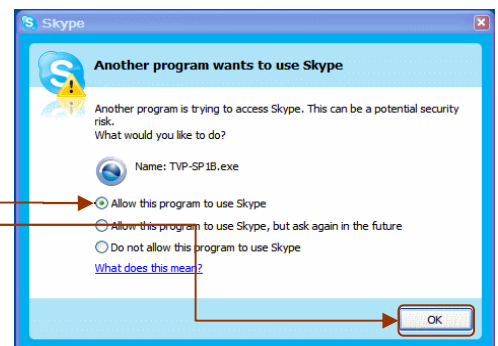
20. To finishing Bluetooth pairing click **OK**.

22. Select **Allow the program to use Skype** and then click **OK**.

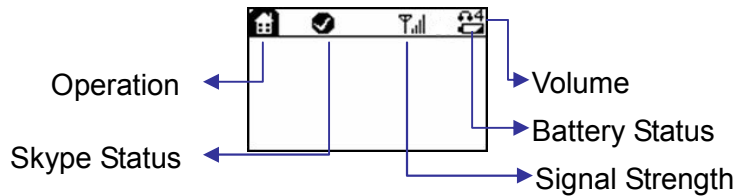

Main page

Press  to go to main page.

4 possible cases on main page:

1. Bluetooth is disconnected: LCD shows “BT Phone”, Signal strength icon is disconnected
2. Bluetooth is connected but skype is not signed in: LCD shows “BT Phone / Skype Unavailable”, Signal strength icon shows levels of signal strength
3. Bluetooth is connected and skype is signed in: LCD shows “BT Phone”
4. Bluetooth is connected, skype is signed in and has missed calls: LCD shows “BT Phone / # Missed calls”.

Contact List Page

Press  can go to Contact List page

- Show Contacts (Displayname > Full Name > Skype Account)
- Sort by Skype status (Online / Offline)
- Sort by name


Quick Access

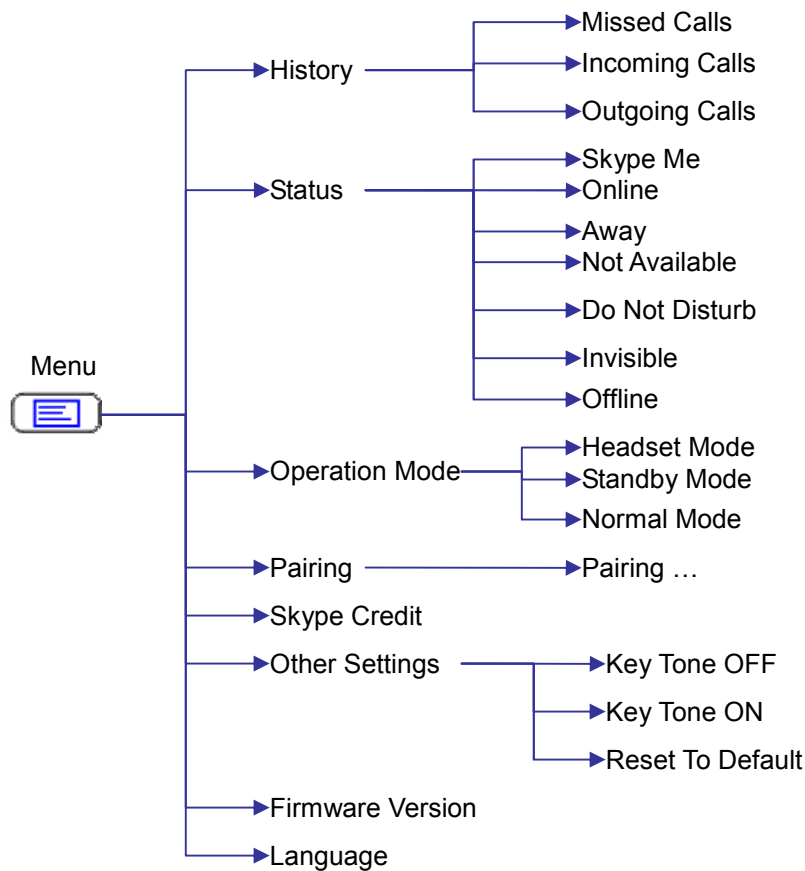
1. Press the first letter of the name. (Press a key once to insert the first letter on the key, twice for the second letter, and so on.)
2. Press ‘1’ to go back to the top of the contact list
3. Press ‘1’ again to go to the last online contact, so you can rolling from bottom to the beginning

Scrolling Long Display Name (long name which cannot be displayed completely on LCD)

1. Press  to move to right.



Guide to Basic Functions


Call Skype™ Contact

1. Press  to turn on device → Wait until phone shows “ClearSky” and signal strength icon shows “connected” → press  to sync contact lists with PC skype
2. Use List button  to scroll up/down the contact lists
3. Press  to start a call.
4. Press  to disconnect this call

Call an ordinary phone number (Skype™ out)




1. Enter “+” () + phone number you want to call. (Press  to delete an incorrect digit)
2. Press  to start a call.

Answer a call

1. Press  to answer any incoming call.

Make a Conference Call




A. invite another contact when you are chatting

1. Make 1st call
2. Press  to invite 2nd contact → Press  to place the call
3. Choose “CON CALL”  to invite 2nd contact to join this conference call with 1st contact



1. P2P CALL

4. Choose "P2P CALL" **2. CON CALL** to hold 1st call and talk to 2nd contact.





B. invite contacts and conference them together

1. Press  to go to the contact list menu.
2. Press  to mark the contact you want to include in this conference call. (Conference participants (max 4+host))
3. Press  to start this conference call

Redial outgoing calls


1. Press  to show outgoing call lists.
2. Select the contact (from the outgoing call list) you want to dial to make a call.
3. Press  to make a call

Redial any call from History

1. Redial from Missed Calls: Press  → History → Missed → Choose one contact to dial. (press  to cancel this action and go back to home)
2. Redial from Incoming Calls: Press  → History → Incoming Calls → Choose one contact to dial.
3. Redial from Outgoing Calls: Press  → History → Outgoing Calls → Choose one contact to dial.

Operations during a call

Mute Microphone




- Press  to mute / unmute microphone




Hold a call

- Press  to hold / continue the call

Note: According to Bluetooth spec, the signal range of Class 1 is 100 meters. 100 meters is the maximum distance that is realistically possible. The environment where the Bluetooth phone kits are been used might have effect on the actual distance that can be attained.

Troubleshooting

Problem: Press “Power on” button, but nothing happen, no display

Solution:

1. Make sure the included rechargeable battery is fitted in the handset correctly.

Problem: Pop up a Bluetooth Security window

Solution:

1. Bluetooth PIN should be self-assigned when pairing with Bluetooth phone. If this window pop up, please input default Bluetooth PIN: “0000”.

Question: How to distinguish standby mode and power-off mode

Answer: Please check LED, if LED is not blinking, Bluetooth phone is in power-off mode. If LED blinks every 5 seconds, Phone is in standby mode.

Problem: No response on your phone (LCD stuck in the same page no matter which key you enter).

Solution: Please remove battery to restart your Bluetooth phone.

Problem: PC music plays in Bluetooth phone

Solution: When you finish installation, system default audio device will be set to Bluetooth wave. If you want to change back to PC original default audio device, please go to Settings→Control Panel→Sounds and Audio Devices→Audio to choose default device.

Problem: Why can I just invite one contact to join my current call?

Solution: If you need to hold a conference call with more than 2 contacts, please choose contacts first and then make a conference call. For “join” function, our phone just allow one participant to join current call.

Problem: Another ringer during my conversation

Solution: This means another incoming call is waiting for your response. You can answer this call and hold current one by pressing “off-hook” or reject this incoming call by pressing “on-hook”

Question: What’s the time period before the phone goes into standby mode?

Answer: 6 minutes

Problem: One warning sound made by Bluetooth phone

Solution: This might be “low battery warning” signal. Please check your battery icon to see when it shows “no”. Please use the included USB cable to charge Bluetooth phone.
