Test Procedure: For testing performed with the loop antenna, testing was performed in accordance to ANSI C63.4 section 8.2.1. The The center of the loop was positioned 1 m above the ground and positioned with its plane vertical at the specied distance from the EUT. During testing the loop was rotated about its vertical axis for maximum response at each azimuth and also investigated with the loop positioned in the horizontal plane.

#### Other emissions

Test Procedure: The procedure used was ANSI Standard C63.4-2003. The receive was scanned from 30MHz to 1000MHz.When an emission was found, the table was rotated to produce the maximum signal strength. An initial pre-scan was performed for in peak detection mode using the receiver. The EUT was measured for both the Horizontal and Vertical polarities and performed a pretest three orthogonal planes. The worst case emissions were reported.

An initial pre-scan was performed in the 3m chamber using the spectrum analyser in peak detection mode. Quasi-peak measurements were conducted based on the peak sweep graph. The EUT was measured by Bilog antenna with 2 orthogonal polarities

#### Remark:



The requirement to contain the 20 dB bandwidth of the emission within the specified frequency band includes the effects from frequency sweeping, frequency hopping and other modulation techniques that may be employed as well as the frequency stability of the transmitter over expected variations in temperature and supply voltage. If a frequency stability is not specified in the regulations, it is recommended that the fundamental emission be kept within at least the central 80% of the permitted band in order to minimize the possibility of out- of-band operation.
