Confidentiality of the internal photos is being requested because this is a non-consumer device which is not accessible by the general public, professionally installed, and is only serviceable by the Itron, or designated technicians.

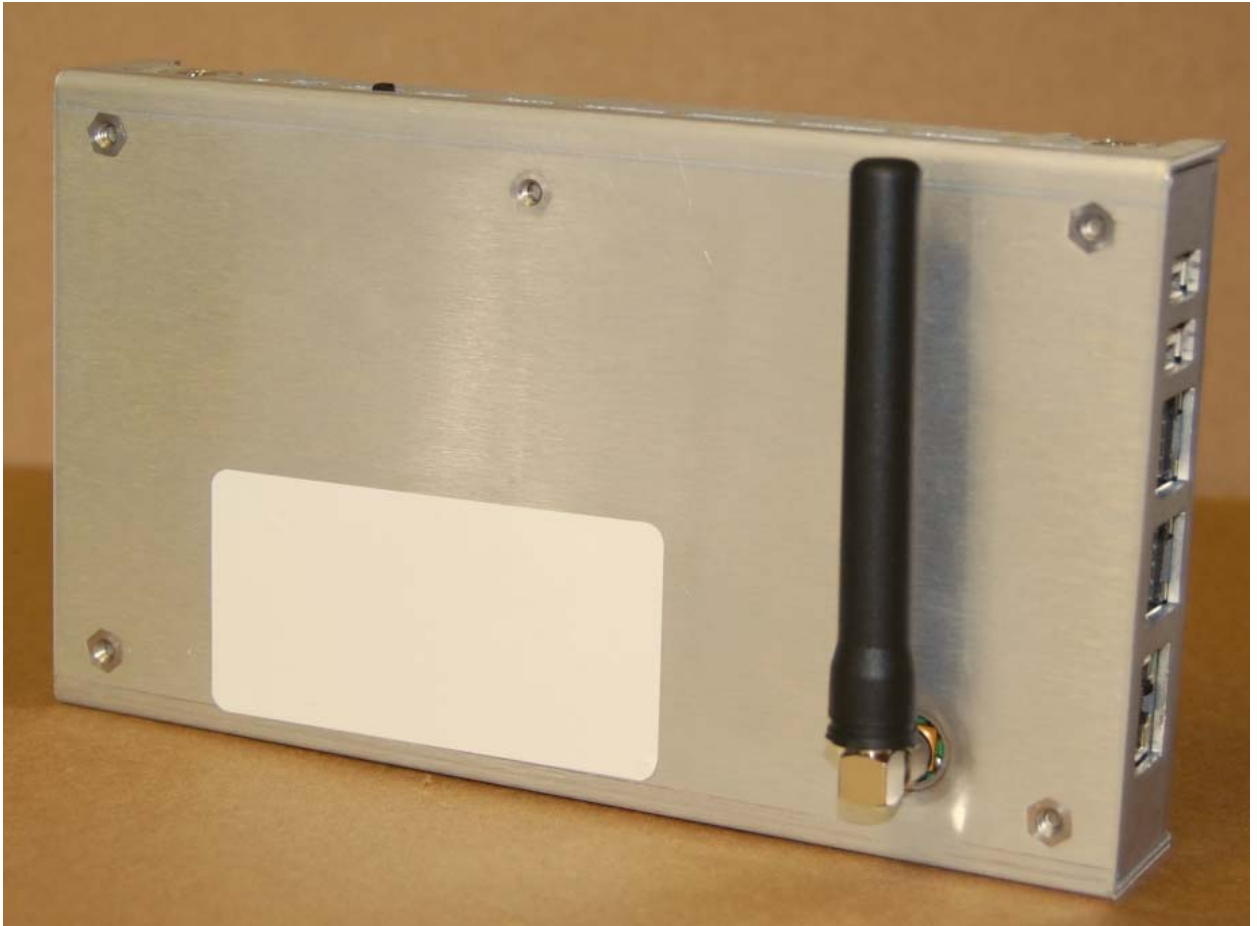


Figure 1: Itron Module ITR24001, FCC ID: SK9ITR24001
