

You can Create a Virtual Leash, by pressing the Virtual Leash tab on the app, selecting the StickNFind sticker you would like to create the Virtual Leash, select the approximate range and Ringtone Alert. You can run other apps, as long as you keep the StickNFind app working on the Background. To stop or cancel a Virtual leash, go the Virtual Leash tab on the app, and press Stop on Virtual leash. the buzzer make a tone, you can press the Flash button to make the LED flash, or press "Both" for Buzz and Flash. Sticking the StickNFind to a surface: First make sure the surface you would like to stick the StickNFind is clean. Really clean! This is very important, as even if it might look clean, microscopic dust will prevent the adhesive to proper bond. If you completely close the app, it will also terminate the Virtual Leash. One the area is clean, peel the back label of the Adhesive, and press hard. Try to press hard for some seconds. You must wait 1 hour for the adhesive to cure. Reverse Virtual Leash: By going on the Reverse Virtual Leash or RVL feature, you can select a sticker, that you would like to be paired always with your phone. If you leave your phone behind, the RVL Sticker will Buzz and Flash, After 1 hour the adhesive will be at 60% cured. After 12 hours it will be 80% cured, and after 24 hours it will reach its emending you that you left your phone behind. StickNFind app must be running always on the background maximum strength. You can still use it after 1 hour, but try not to remove it or play with it until its fully cured. To cancel RVL with a sticker, go to the RVL feature, and select Stop. This will terminate the RVL mode. Should you need to remove it, Peel it, remove the old Glue, and use any 2 side tape or glue to stick to the new surface. Changing the Battery: Find It Feature: There is a small gap on the side, between the top cover and lower cover. With your nail, slightly pull the bottom Press the Find It feature on the StickNFind app. Select the StickNFind sticker you would like to find. Once that Sticker is cover off. Remove the old battery and place the new in Range, your phone will Alert you. Battery. To close the cover, there is a small dent on the bottom cover. Align the dent to be on-top of the matching area. Close the cover, and make sure all sides are equally Radar Feature: closed. You can slightly turn the bottom cover until it fully then you are trying to find a Sticker, you can always launch a Radar Feature. It will show you all the Stickers within matches. You will hear 4 beeps to confirm the unit is on. ige. Press on the Sticker you would like to find. A new **FCC Notices** dow will open.
