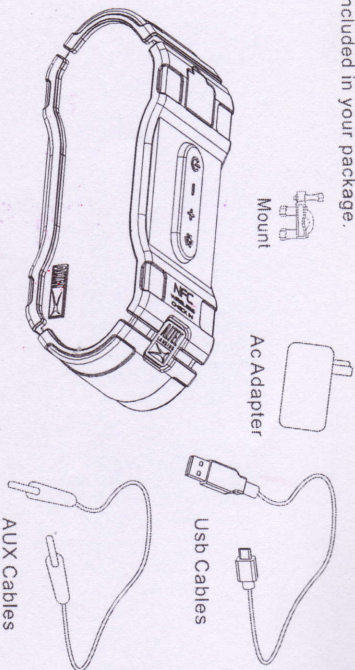
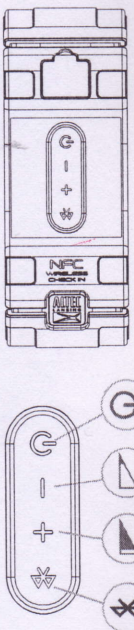


Quick Start Guide for Omni Jacket Model:IMW678

1. Make sure the following items are included in your package.



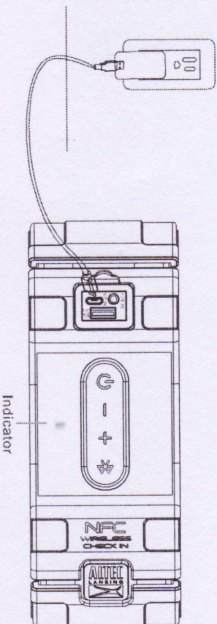
2. For a look at the various buttons on your speaker, view the graphic below.



- Power On..... Press \odot
- Power Off..... Hold \odot 2seconds
- Play / Pause..... Press \odot
- Volume Up / Down..... Press + or -
- Disconnect device..... Press *
- Battery status..... Press \odot and +
- Voice Control..... Press \odot 2 times
- Answer / End call..... Press \odot
- Multiple Connection..... Hold * 2seconds

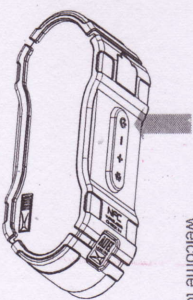
3. Connect the included USB Cable to the the included AC adapter to charge your speaker's internal battery. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours.

Charging: When charging, an orange LED light will illuminate. The orange light will turn off when your unit is fully charged.



4. Pairing a Single speaker with Bluetooth Device

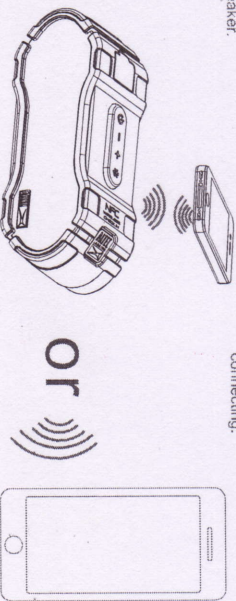
Turn on OMNI JACKET, the \odot button Powering on will be announced
 Flashing blue light denotes that the speaker is ready to be paired



Once powered on, you will hear your speaker audibly say "Powering ON welcome to Aitec Lansing"

5. Pair the Speaker Using NFC

With Near Field Communication(NFC), you can easily pair and connect your speaker to your compatible device. Just hold your NFC enabled device directly against the wireless check in spot on your speaker.



Power on your speaker. Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your Bluetooth device. Search Bluetooth devices and select "Boomjacket" to start connecting.

Once paired, you will hear your speaker audibly say: "You are now paired, enjoy."

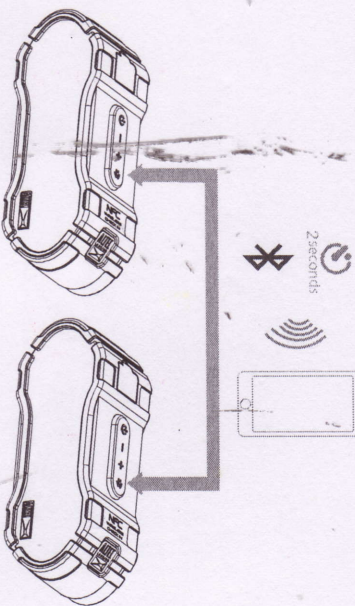
7. MULTIPLE CONNECTION

When you want to play Multi Connection, you connect two OMNI JACKET together for bigger sound.

You can Multi Connect two OMNI JACKET without the app: Press and hold the Bluetooth button for 2 seconds on the speaker that is playing music.

Then press and hold the Bluetooth button for 2 seconds on the speaker that you want to add.

The connected two speakers will play the same music from the same device.

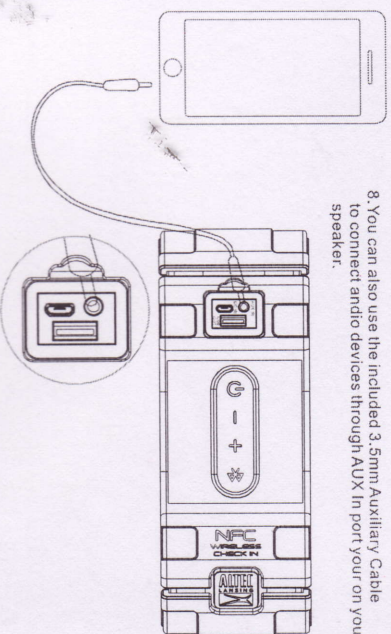


6. Download the "ALTEC CONNECT" app for iOS and Android

allows you to personalize your OMNI JACKET

- You Can:
- Enable Multi Connection setting.
 - Monitor the battery level and charging status
 - Select EQ Sound setting.
 - Control Play/Pause/Skip/Volume/Mute
 - Over The Air Update software of OMNI JACKET.

8. You can also use the included 3.5mm Auxiliary Cable to connect audio devices through AUX in port your on your speaker.
