### Compatible devices



iPhone 4s & later, iPad 3rd Generation & later, and Android 4.4 & later.

02

### Download TrackR app



Search the App Store or Google Play for TrackR.

03

### Turn Bluetooth ON



Make sure your phone's Bluetooth is turned ON, and open the TrackR app.

04

### Location & Bluetooth



Accept the requested app permissions. If using an iPhone and you accidentally did not accept, go to Settings > Privacy > Location Services, and set TrackR to "always"

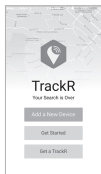
### Register (optional)



Register for Crowd GPS. You will receive an email to confirm your account. When done, select "Register".

06

### Select "Add a New Device"



When prompted, select "Add a New Device".

07

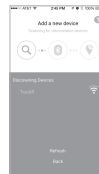
### Press button



Press the button on the device. You should hear a beep and the device should blink.

08

### Select "TrackR"



Select "TrackR" and the device will connect (this may take up to 1 minute). If you don't see the TrackR device listed, verify Bluetooth & press "refresh"

09

### Select device



Select the icon you want for the item or belonging you are tracking.

10

### Complete



Setup is complete. Enjoy your TrackR!
