This transmitter was designed to operate in following frequency ranges: 450-470MHz  
To aid equipment authorization in other countries which accept the United States FCC Grant for Certification,

Raveon Technologies Corporation is requesting that the FCC lists the above frequency/frequencies under FCC Rule Part 90 on the FCC Grant.

For the FCC's Rule Part 90 applications, this radio is used in systems by Federal and Public Safety agencies including Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services, etc. as indicated in the table below. Equipment programming is the responsibility of Authorized Service Personnel. Also, the radio complies with 47 CFR Part 90.203(e), in that the operator cannot directly program the transmit frequencies using the normally accessible external controls.

Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operates on unauthorized frequencies.
