
NOTE: This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B didited device, pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection aginst harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment generates, use and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause hrmful interference to radio communications.

However, there is no guarantee that interference will not occur in a particular installation. If this equipment does cause harmful interference to radio or television reception, which can be determined by turning the equipment off and on, the user is encouraged to try to correct the interference by one or more of the following measures:

- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.
- Increase the separation between the equipment and receiver.

CONTROL LOCATION




CONNECTING POWER

Plug the micro USB of the supplied cord into the DC IN USB jack at the back of the unit. Plug the other end USB jack to the adapter USB socket and plug the adapter body into the standard AC wall socket. Press **U** button to turn on or off unit (standby mode).

Blue color indicator light = Unit turn on Bluetooth mode.

Green color indicator light = Unit turn on Line In mode.



CAUTION:

The unit is designed to operate from a mains supply of AC 120V~60Hz. If the adapter does not fit properly, turn it over and again. Do not force it.

NOTE: When the unit is not operated by the AC power or unused for long periods of the time. Please remove the power adapter from the wall outlet and unplug from the main unit.

USING THE BUILT-IN BATTERY

Built-in battery for power operation

- 1. Connect AC power following "CONNECTING POWER" step.
- 2. Red LED indicator light on speaker grill
- 3. After approximately 8-10 hours, the red LED indicator light off means fully charged.
- 4. Remove the adapter from the back of the unit to operate the unit.
- 5. At this moment, the unit can operate by built-in battery.


NOTES:

- 1. Do not open batteries.
- 2. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- 3. Do not heat up batteries.
- 4. Do not expose batteries to water.

USING LINE IN (AUX IN) JACK

You can play any portable or external audio device with a standard 3.5mm stereo audio cable (not included) via the LINE IN jack on the unit.


- Plug one end of a standard 3.5mm stereo audio cable into the earphone or line-out jack on your external device and plug the another end of the audio cable into the unit's LINE IN jack.
- 2. Press U button to turn on unit. Green color indicator light on speaker grill.
- 3. Turn on and play your external audio device.
- 4. Press the **VOLUME** buttons to set the speaker volume level. You may need to adjust the volume on your external device as well.
- 5. To stop the LINE IN playback, Press U button to turn off unit.
- 6. Remember to turn off your external audio device after playback.



Charging Your Mobile Battery

Use USB of unit to charging your mobile phone.

- 1. Pull out the USB charge cable carefully.
- 2. Connect to your mobile phone micro / mini USB port.
- 3. At this moment, your mobile will start charging and battery charge icon will show on mobile phone display.



LISTENING TO A BLUETOOTH DEVICE

FIRST PAIRING WITH A BLUETOOTH ENABLED DEVICE

If the unit has never been paired with a Bluetooth device before, you need to follow the pairing instructions below to link the unit with your Bluetooth device.

- 1. Press the **U** button to turn on the unit.
- 2. Waiting for four to five seconds or press and hold the **PAIRING** button the Bluetooth color LED will start flashing rapidly on the speaker grill. The unit will will then go into Pairing/Discoverable mode.
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth device and enable the search or scan function to find nearby Bluetooth devices.
- 4. Select "ISB394" from the device list when it appears on your device screen.
- 5. After successfully pairing (linking) with a Bluetooth enabled device, the unit will emit a short beep and the Bluetooth icon will light steadily.

NOTE:

If you cannot pair the unit with your Bluetooth enabled device, try solving the problem by turning the unit power on and off and then starting the pairing process again.

AFTER FIRST PAIRING

If the unit has already been paired with a Bluetooth enabled device before, it will automatically start searching for the last paired device. Once it is found, the Bluetooth icon will light steadily. You can now start playing music from your Bluetooth enabled device wirelessly to the speaker.

- 1. Press the **VOLUME** buttons on the unit to adjust the volume level.
- 2. After selecting the music track from your mobile for you want to listen to, press the ► button on the unit to play or pause the music track.
- 3. If you want to pair the unit with another Bluetooth device, press and hold the PAIRING button for 4-5 seconds to disconnect the existing connection. The unit will emit two short beeps and the Bluetooth icon will be flashing rapidly on the LCD. The unit will then go into Pairing/ Discoverable mode again. Repeat the last two steps from the "First pairing"

NOTE:

- a) Refer to the user manual of your mobile phone, tablet, or other Bluetooth enabled device for further instructions on Bluetooth operation, as Bluetooth operation may vary from model to model.
- b) If your Bluetooth enabled device does not support A2DP profile, it will not play music through the speaker, even if paired (linked).
- c) This unit cannot support pairing with computer.



ANSWER THE INCOMING CALL

When your unit playing mobile music by Bluetooth and receiving an incoming call on your mobile phone, the music will be stop and ring sound from your mobile phone. Just end the call that the music will sound automatic.
