#### Prediction of MPE Limit

### 1. Description of EUT

#### 2. Friis Formula

Friis transmission formula : S =  $(P_{out}*G) / (4*\pi*r^2)$  $R = \sqrt{\frac{PG}{4 \pi S}}$ 

 $S = power density in mW/cm^2$ 

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

R = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd is the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>. If we know the maximum Gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

#### 3. EUT Operating condition

The software provided by Manufacturer enabled the EUT to Maximum Output Power with downlink and uplink mode.

## 4. Test Results

#### 4.1 Antenna Gain

The maximum Gain measured in Fully Anechoic Chamber is 20.15dBi or 103.514 (numeric).
