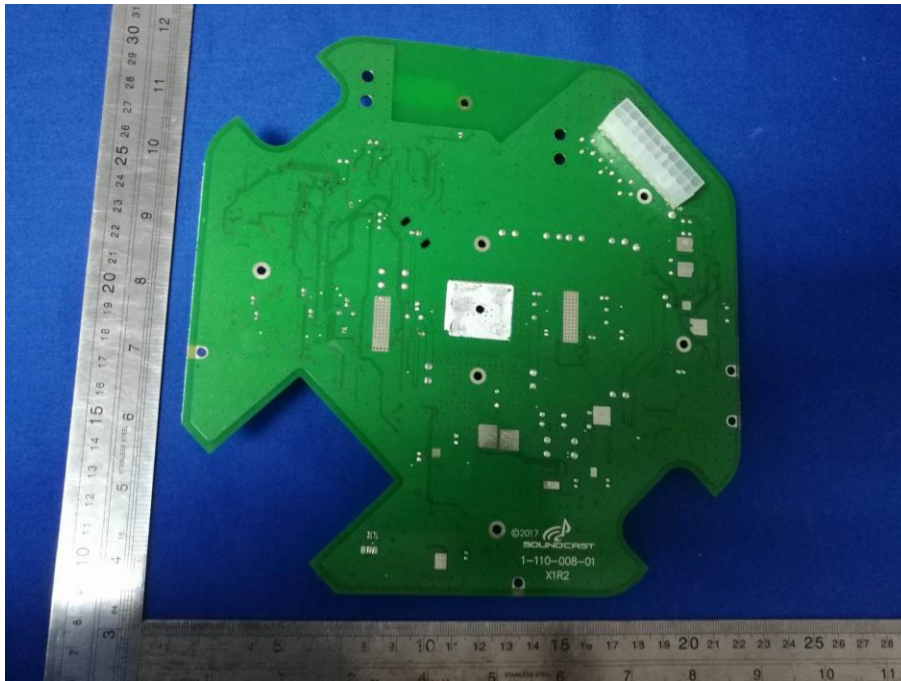

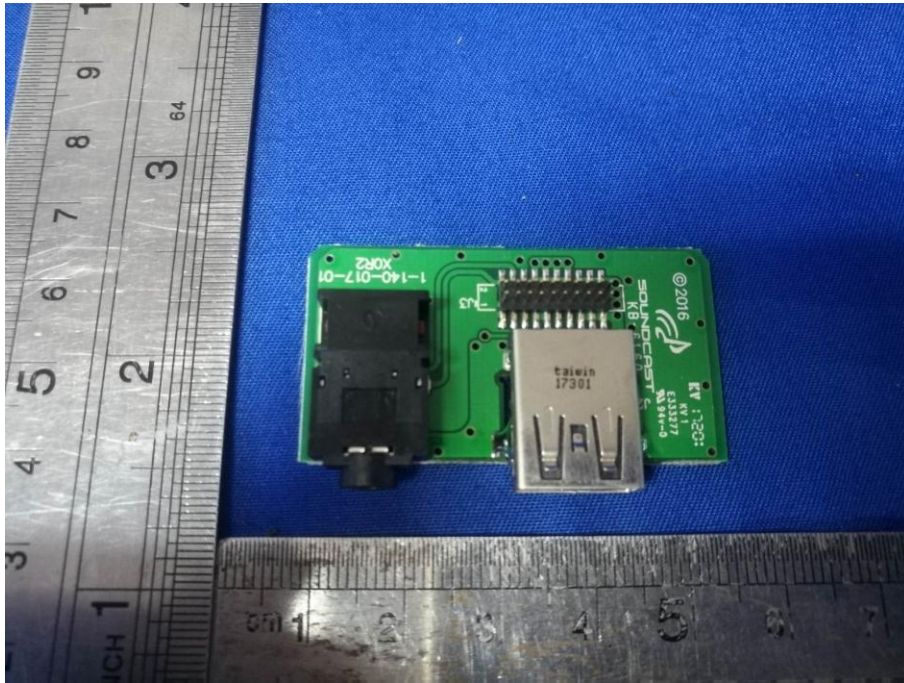

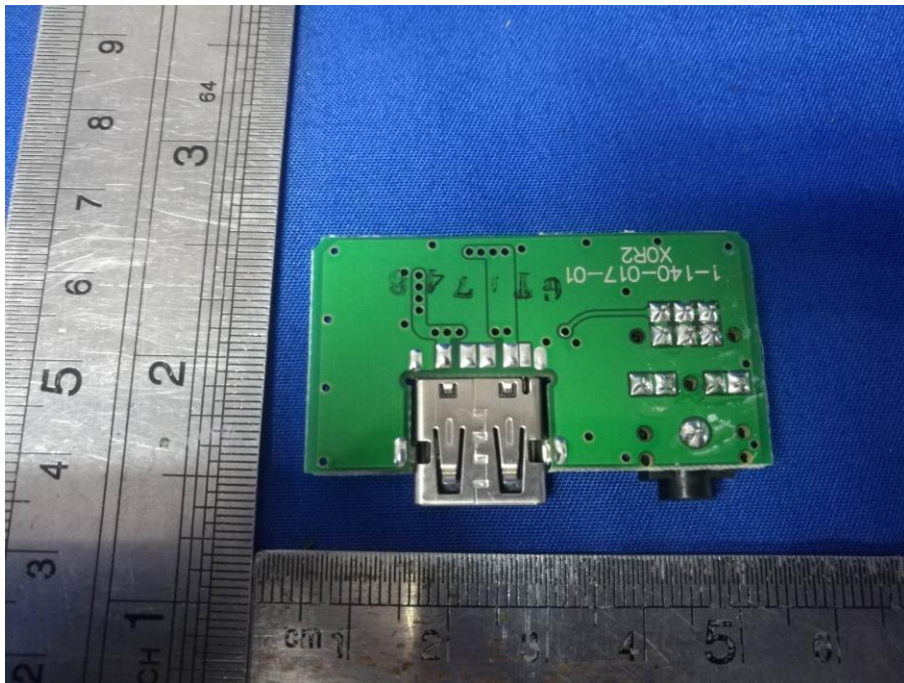

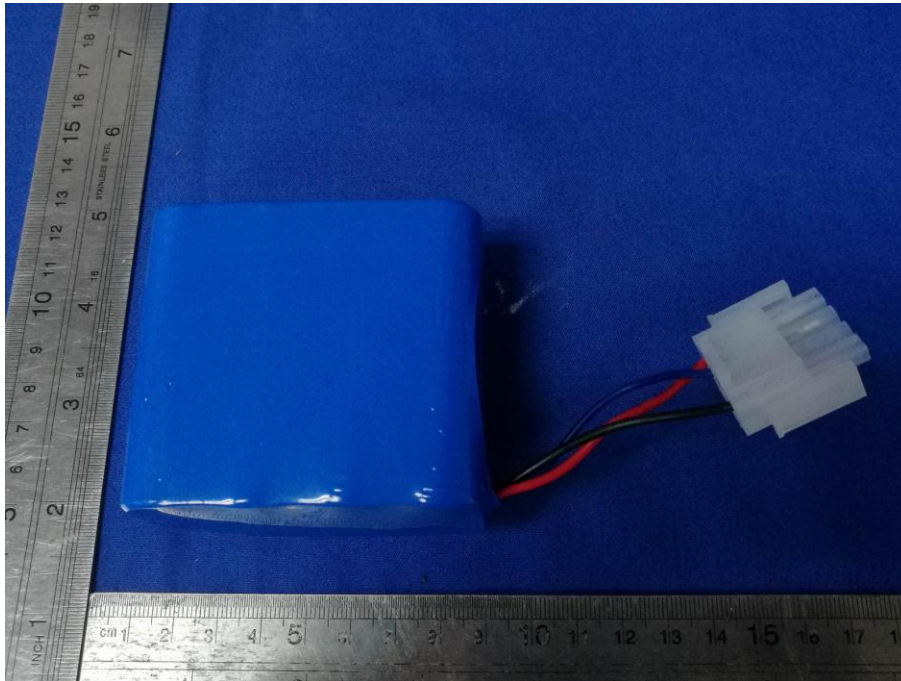

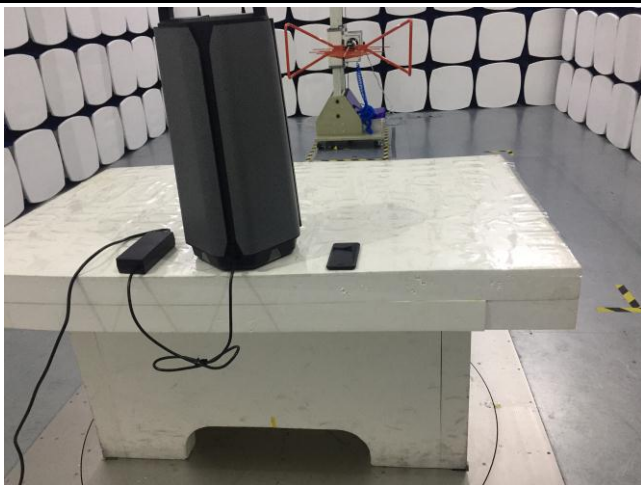

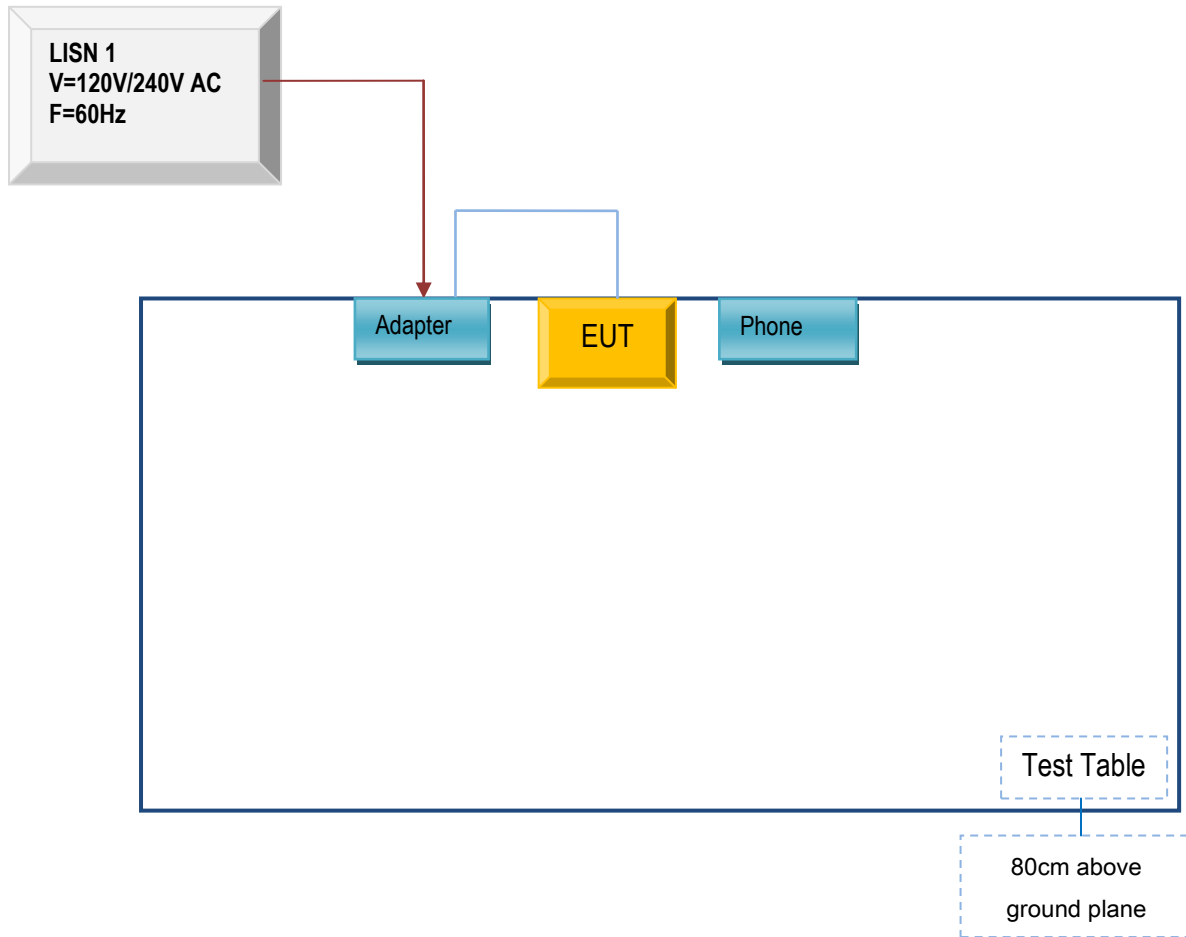

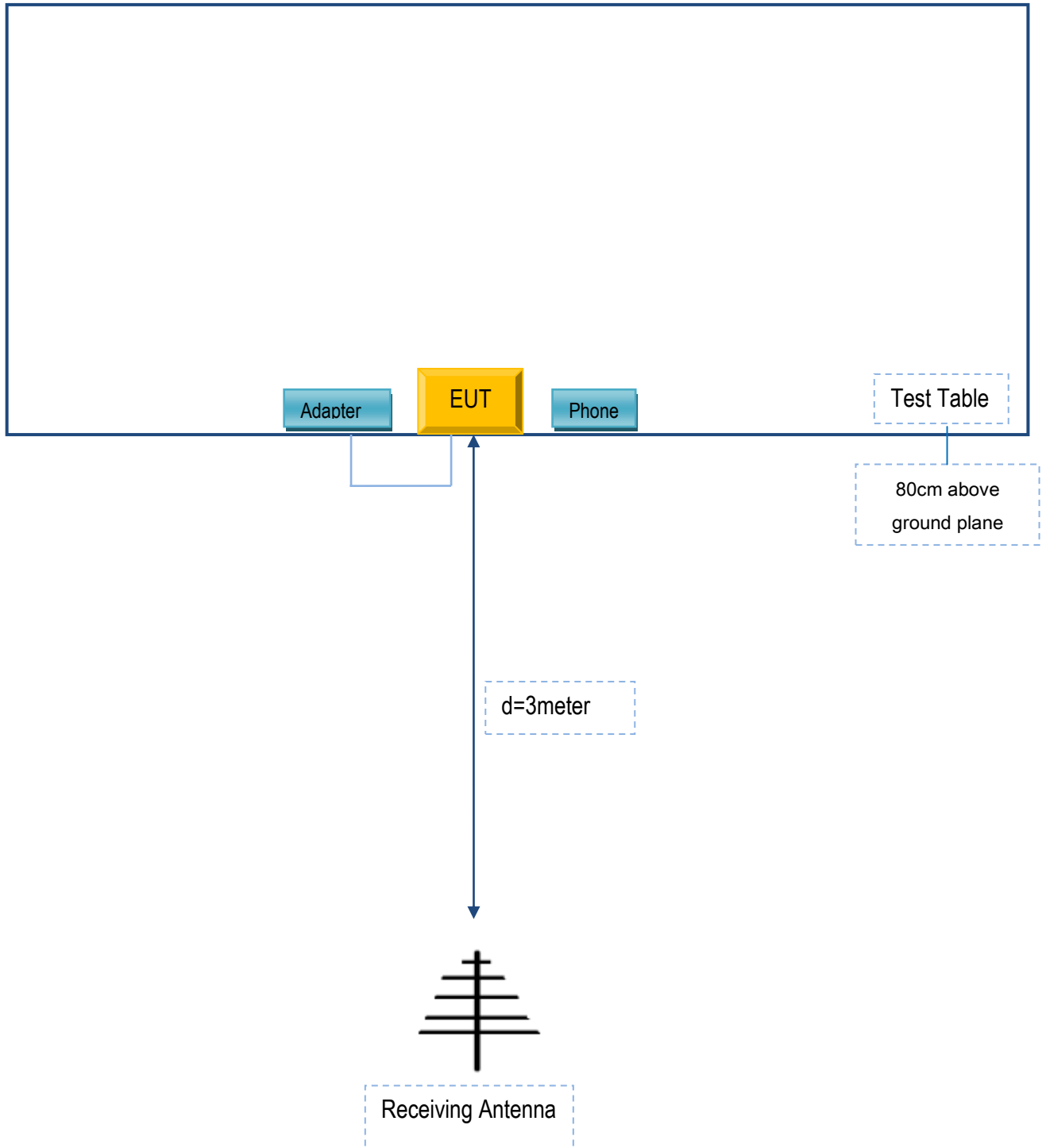

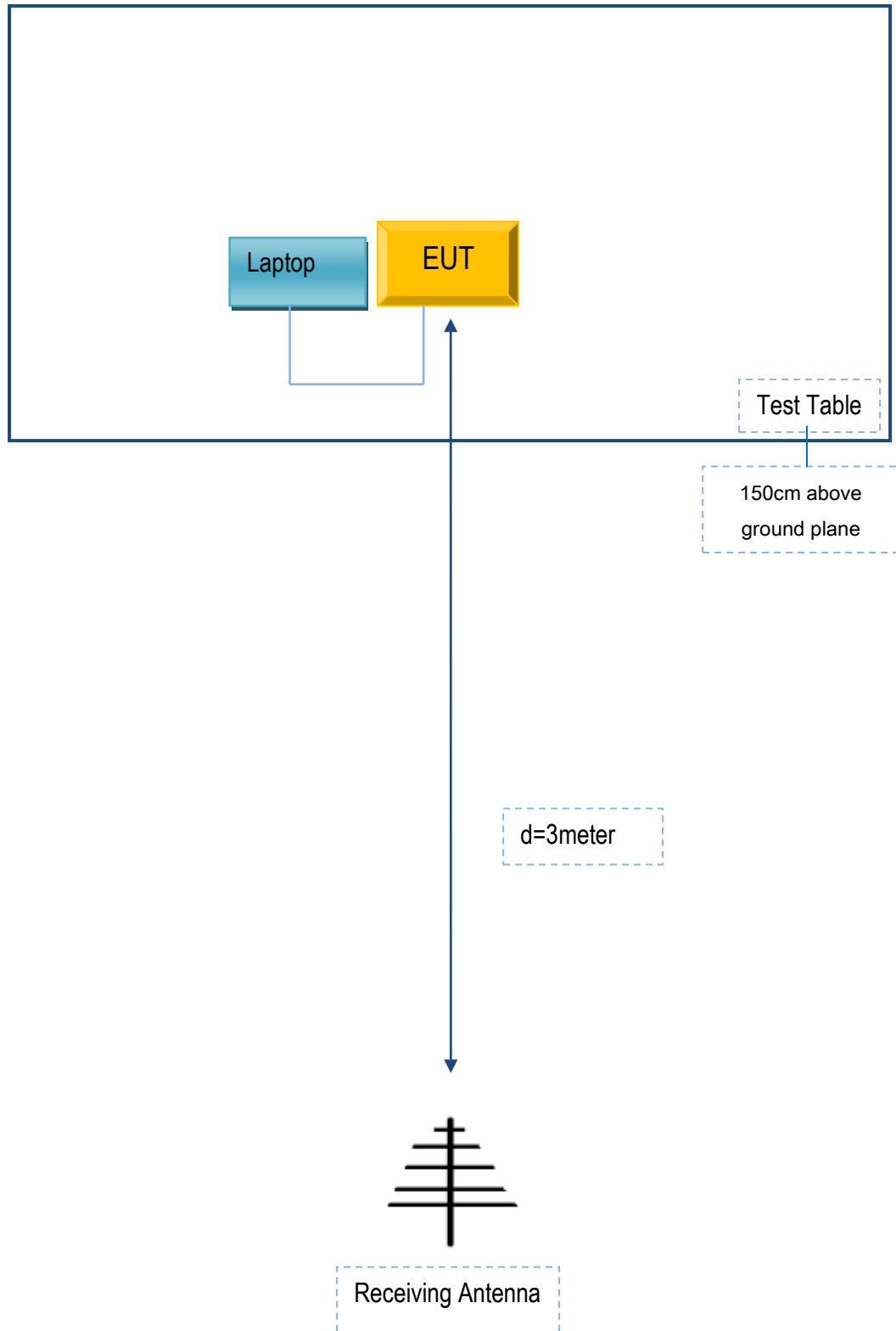
#### Block Configuration Diagram for AC Line Conducted Emissions
