



Step 1 With power off of the location, remove the existing mounting bracket from the junction box. It is important to not disconnect the wires. **DO NOT** connect the junction box to power source until you are ready to install the camera.



Step 2 If you are using the mounting bracket with the junction box, remove the mounting bracket from the junction box. If you are not using the mounting bracket, skip this step.

Note: If you are using the mounting bracket with the junction box, you will need to use the provided mounting bracket with your camera.



Step 3 Turn the equipment back on to power the lights, and then adjust the light (if applicable) to go back to its mounting location.



Step 4 Hook one end of the hook into the hole on the mounting bracket and the other end to the edge of the camera. To see how to hook the camera into the mounting bracket, see the diagram below.

Note: If you are using the mounting bracket with the junction box, you will need to use the provided mounting bracket with your camera.



Step 5 The copper wire from the camera is ground wire. Connect the ground wire together. Use one of the provided wire nuts to connect the wires.



Step 6 Connect the power wires. The white wire from the camera is neutral wire. Connect the white wire to the neutral wire. The black wire from the camera is hot wire. Connect the hot wire to the hot wire.

Note: If you are using the mounting bracket with the junction box, you will need to use the provided mounting bracket with your camera.



Step 7 Put away the wires, attach the camera to the mounting bracket, and then use the camera with mounting screws.



Step 8 Adjust the camera position on the perimeter of the bracket. When you are ready to the mounting surface, use the screws to secure the camera to the mounting surface and the back box.

Note: If you are using the mounting bracket with the junction box, you will need to use the provided mounting bracket with your camera.



Step 9 After the installation is complete, turn on the power to the camera. The camera will be powered on and ready to use.
