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## GENERAL INFORMATION

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### Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The **Shenzhen KingBoard Technology Co., Ltd.**'s product, model number: **KTS-806 (FCC ID: SXXKTS-806)** (the "EUT") in this report was a **Bluetooth Speaker**, which was measured approximately: 25.8 cm (L) × 12.5 cm (W) × 12.5 cm (H), rated input voltage: DC3.7V battery and 5V from DC.

*\*All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from final production sample, serial number: 161228805 (assigned by the BACL, Chengdu). It may have deviation from any other sample. The EUT supplied by the applicant was received on 2016-12-30, and EUT conformed to test requirement.*

### Objective

This report is prepared on behalf of **Shenzhen KingBoard Technology Co., Ltd.** in accordance with Part 2, Subpart J, Part 15, Subparts A, B and C of the Federal Communications Commission's rules

The tests were performed in order to determine the Bluetooth BDR and EDR mode of EUT compliance with FCC Part 15, Subpart C, and section 15.203, 15.205, 15.207, 15.209 and 15.247 rules.

### Related Submittal(s)/Grant(s)

No related submittal grant.

### Test Methodology

All measurements contained in this report were conducted with ANSI C63.10-2013, American National Standard of Procedures for Compliance Testing of Unlicensed Wireless Devices.

The uncertainty of any RF tests which use conducted method measurement is  $\pm 3.17$  dB, the uncertainty of any radiation on emissions measurement is:

30M~200MHz:  $\pm 4.7$  dB;  
200M~1GHz:  $\pm 6.0$  dB;  
1G~6GHz:  $\pm 5.13$ dB;  
6G~25GHz:  $\pm 5.47$ dB;

And the uncertainty will not be taken into consideration for all test data recorded in the report.

## **Test Facility**

The test site used by BACL to collect test data is located in the 5040, HuiLongWan Plaza, No. 1, ShaWan Road, JinNiu District, ChengDu, China

Test site at BACL has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on April 24, 2015. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2014.

The Federal Communications Commission has the reports on file and is listed under FCC Registration No.: 560332. The test site has been approved by the FCC for public use and is listed in the FCC Public Access Link (PAL) database.

No modification was made to the EUT.

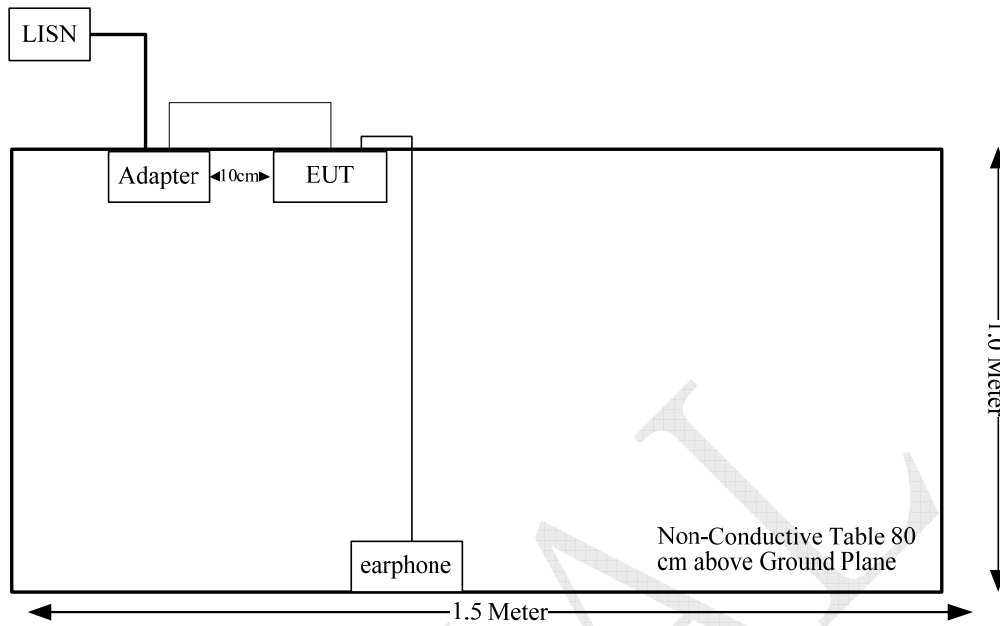

## **FCC §15.247 (i) & §1.1310 & §2.1093- RF EXPOSURE**

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### **Applicable Standard**

According to §15.247(i) and §1.1310, systems operating under the provisions of this section shall be operated in a manner that ensure that the public is not exposed to radio frequency energy level in excess of the Commission's guideline.

According to KDB447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06:

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances  $\leq 50$  mm are determined by:

$[(\text{max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW}) / (\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] \cdot [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}] \leq 3.0$  for 1-g SAR and  $\leq 7.5$  for 10-g extremity SAR, where

- $f(\text{GHz})$  is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz
- Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation
- The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison
- 3.0 and 7.5 are referred to as the numeric thresholds in the step 2 below

The test exclusions are applicable only when the minimum test separation distance is  $\leq 50$  mm and for transmission frequencies between 100 MHz and 6 GHz. When the minimum test separation distance is  $< 5$  mm, a distance of 5 mm according to 5) in section 4.1 is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

### **Measurement Result**

The max conducted power including tune-up tolerance is -3.0 dBm (0.5 mW).  
 $[(\text{max. power of channel, mW}) / (\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}]$   
 $= 0.5/5 \cdot (\sqrt{2.480}) = 0.2 < 3.0$

**So the stand-alone SAR evaluation is not necessary.**

## **FCC §15.203 - ANTENNA REQUIREMENT**

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### **Applicable Standard**

According to FCC § 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the provisions of this Section. The manufacturer may design the unit so that a broken antenna can be replaced by the user, but the use of a standard antenna jack or electrical connector is prohibited.

### **Antenna Connector Construction**

The EUT has one internal antenna arrangement for BT, and the antenna gain is 3.0 dBi, fulfill the requirement of this section. Please refer to the EUT photos.

### Measurement Uncertainty

Compliance or non-compliance with a disturbance limit shall be determined in the following manner:

If  $U_{lab}$  is less than or equal to  $U_{cispr}$  of Table 1, then:

- compliance is deemed to occur if no measured disturbance level exceeds the disturbance limit;
- non-compliance is deemed to occur if any measured disturbance level exceeds the disturbance limit.

If  $U_{lab}$  is greater than  $U_{cispr}$  of Table 1, then:

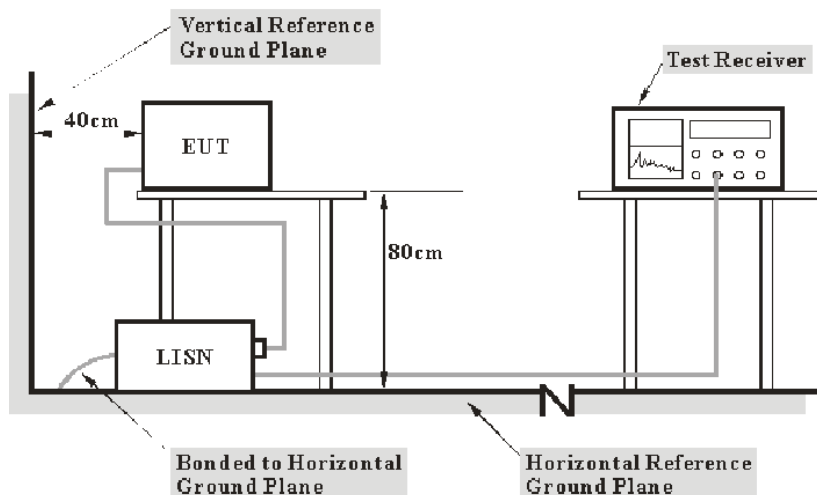
- compliance is deemed to occur if no measured disturbance level, increased by  $(U_{lab} - U_{cispr})$ , exceeds the disturbance limit;
- non-compliance is deemed to occur if any measured disturbance level, increased by  $(U_{lab} - U_{cispr})$ , exceeds the disturbance limit.

Based on CISPR 16-4-2:2011, measurement uncertainty of conducted disturbance at mains port using AMN at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Chengdu) is  $\pm 3.17$  dB (150 kHz to 30 MHz).

### EUT Setup



- Note: 1. Support units were connected to second LISN.  
 2. Both of LISNs (AMN) 80 cm from EUT and at the least 80 cm from other units and other metal planes support units.

The setup of EUT is according with per ANSI C63.10-2013 measurement procedure. The specification used was with the FCC Part 15.207 limits.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

The adapter was connected to a 120 V/60 Hz AC power source.

### EMI Test Receiver Setup

The EMI test receiver was set to investigate the spectrum from 150 kHz to 30 MHz.

During the conducted emission test, the EMI test receiver was set with the following configurations:

Frequency Range	IF B/W
150 kHz – 30 MHz	9 kHz

### Test Procedure

During the conducted emission test, the adapter was connected to the outlet of the first LISN.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions of the EUT.

All data was recorded in the Quasi-peak and average detection mode.

### Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The basic equation is as follows:

$$V_C = V_R + A_C + VDF$$

Herein,

$V_C$ : corrected voltage amplitude

$V_R$ : reading voltage amplitude

$A_C$ : attenuation caused by cable loss

VDF: voltage division factor of AMN or ISN

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance within the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the maximum limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

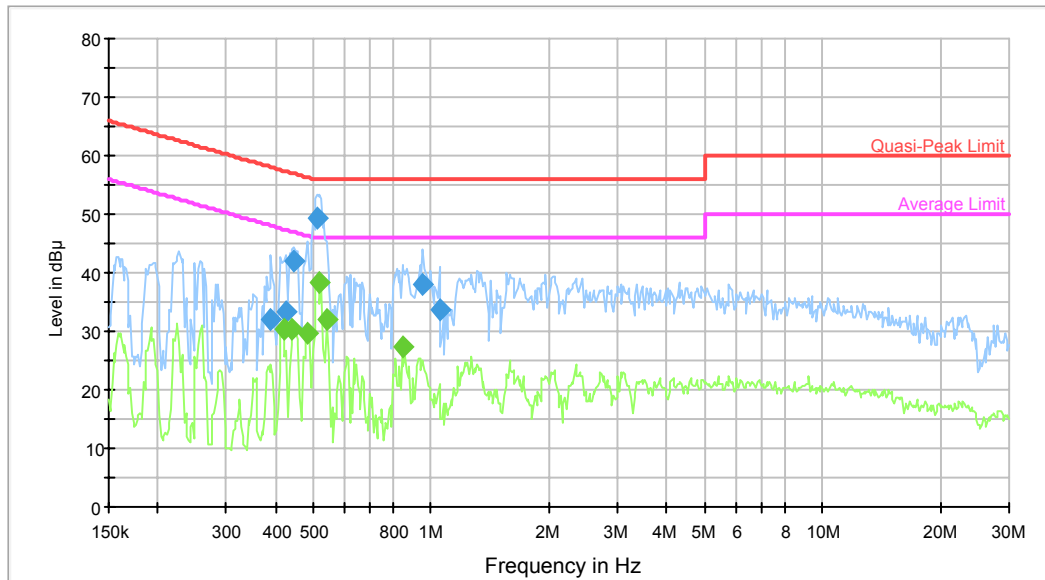

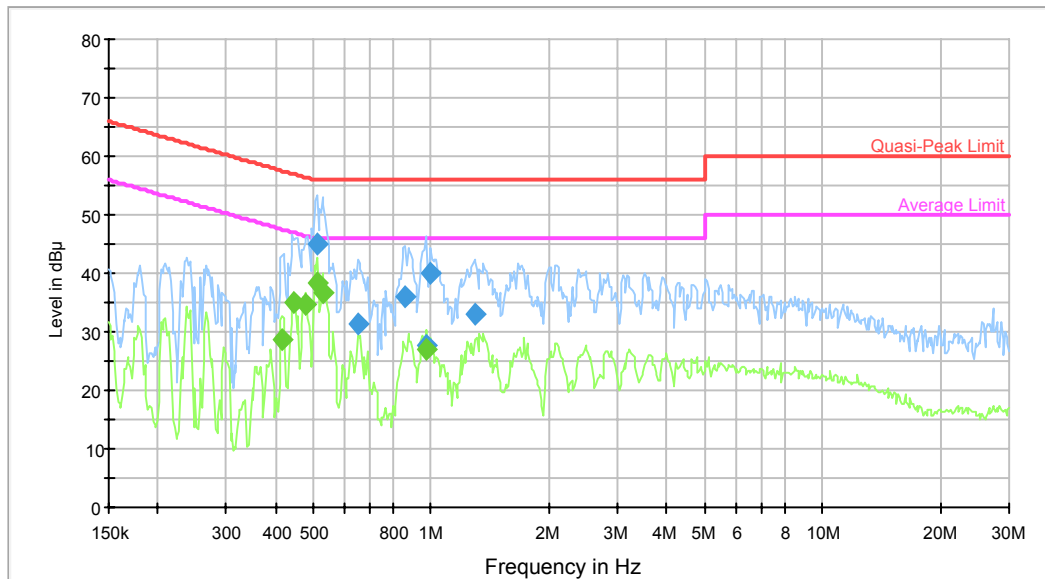

### Measurement Uncertainty

Compliance or non-compliance with a disturbance limit shall be determined in the following manner:

If  $U_{lab}$  is less than or equal to  $U_{cispr}$  of Table 2, then:

–compliance is deemed to occur if no measured disturbance level exceeds the disturbance limit;  
–non-compliance is deemed to occur if any measured disturbance level exceeds the disturbance limit.

If  $U_{lab}$  is greater than  $U_{cispr}$  of Table 2, then:

–compliance is deemed to occur if no measured disturbance level, increased by  $(U_{lab} - U_{cispr})$ , exceeds the disturbance limit;

–non-compliance is deemed to occur if any measured disturbance level, increased by  $(U_{lab} - U_{cispr})$ , exceeds the disturbance limit.

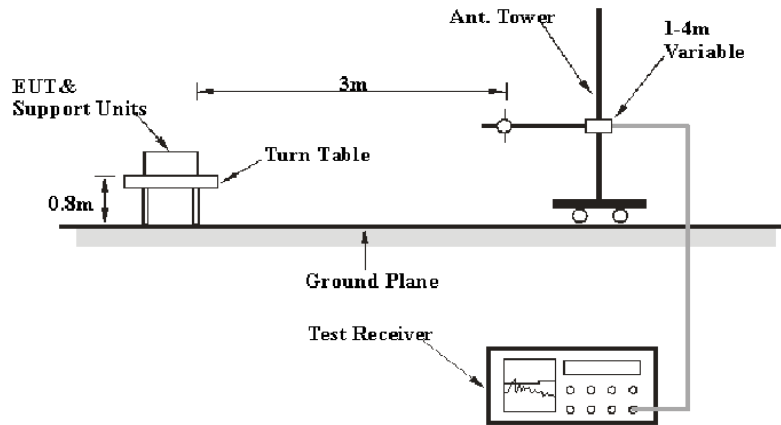

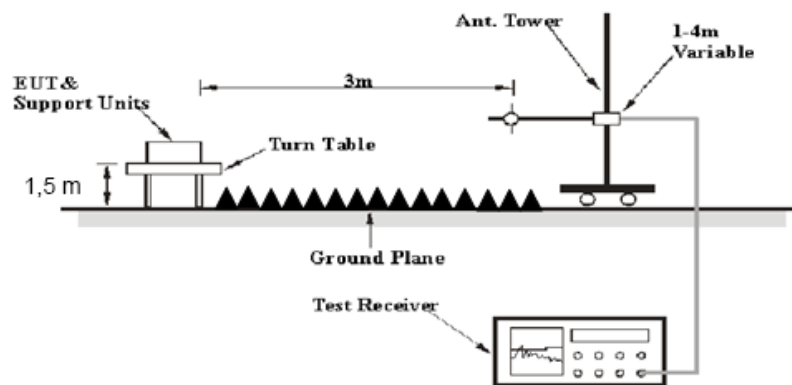


## EUT Setup

The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.10-2013. The specification used was the FCC 15.209, and FCC 15.247 limits.

The external I/O cables were draped along the test table and formed a bundle 30 to 40 cm long in the middle.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

## EMI Test Receiver & Spectrum Analyzer Setup

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 25 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the EMI test receiver & Spectrum Analyzer Setup were set with the following configurations:

## Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

Data was recorded in Quasi-peak detection mode for frequency range of 30 MHz - 1 GHz, peak and average detection modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.

### Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

$$\text{Corrected Amplitude} = \text{Meter Reading} + \text{Antenna Factor} + \text{Cable Loss} - \text{Amplifier Gain}$$

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

## FCC §15.247(d) - BAND EDGES TESTING

### Applicable Standard

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated intentional radiator is operating, the radio frequency power that is produced by the intentional radiator shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement, provided the transmitter demonstrates compliance with the peak conducted power limits. If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of RMS averaging over a time interval, as permitted under paragraph (b)(3) of this section, the attenuation required under this paragraph shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. Attenuation below the general limits specified in §15.209(a) is not required. In addition, radiated emissions which fall in the restricted bands, as defined in §15.205(a), must also comply with the radiated emission limits specified in §15.209(a) (see §15.205(c)).

### Test Procedure

1. Check the calibration of the measuring instrument using either an internal calibrator or a known signal from an external generator.
2. Remove the antenna from the EUT and then connect to a low loss RF cable from the antenna port to a EMI test receiver, then turn on the EUT and make it operate in transmitting mode. Then set it to Low Channel and High Channel within its operating range, and make sure the instrument is operated in its linear range.
3. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 100 kHz with a convenient frequency span including 100 kHz bandwidth from band edge.
4. Measure the highest amplitude appearing on spectral display and set it as a reference level. Plot the graph with marking the highest point and edge frequency.
5. Repeat above procedures until all measured frequencies were complete.
