The purpose of this letter is to request limited modular approval of the Bosch RADION Series, Models RFDW-RM-A, RFDW-SM-A, RFSM-A, RFUN-A, RFKF-A, RFKF-FB-A, RFKF-TB-A, RFPB-TB-A, RFPB-SB-A, RFPR-12-A, RFPR-C12-A, RFRP-A, RFBT-A, motion detectors which operate at 433.42 MHz for periodic operation in the 40.66 – 40.70 MHz and above 70 MHz band under the provisions of FCC Part 15.231. To address the specific numbered items of Public Notice DA 00-1407:

- 1. The modular transmitter has buffered modulation/data inputs.
- 2. The modular transmitter is battery powered and has on board regulation.
- 3. The modular transmitter complies with the antenna requirements of Section 15.203 and 15.204(c). The antenna is permanently attached
- 4. The modular transmitter was tested in a stand-alone configuration.
- 5. The modular transmitter will be labeled with its own FCC ID number.
- 6. The modular transmitter complies with Section 15.231.
- 7. The modular transmitter comply with MPE exposure requirements as a mobile device
