Revolabs is seeking limited modular certification of their UPCS radio, FCC ID: T5VLUCY01, under FCC Part 15D. It will be used in Kogeto's Model Lucy, which is a consumer-oriented panoramic video capturing system that provides an immersive video experience of a recorded environment.

The system is designed to interface with a personal computer, and has been FCC DoC authorized. It features a secondary HD video camera for a detailed perspective, and twin wireless microphones for high fidelity audio. The base unit of the system contains FCC ID: T5VLUCY01.

Lucy will be branded by Teachscape, so their user manual was submitted to support this application. The NWEMC Test report is for the spurious radiated emissions with the module tested in a stand-alone configuration. The Eurofins report is for all other technical requirements of FCC 15D. The UPCS transceiver documented in both test reports is identical.
