

## How to play!



 To turn doll on/off, use switch found on battery compartment inside back of doll.
 Press doll's left hand to play.



2. Match the heart of the doll and animal to hear fun sounds and phrases!

Repeat with all the animals.



3 AA batteries are included for demonstration purposes and may need to be replaced by consumer. Alkaline batteries are recommended. To replace batteries, use Phillips screwdriver to loosen screw on battery compartment cover. Lift cover and replace batteries. Once batteries are replaced, close cover and tighten screw.

Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zine) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
