- 1.) From the information presented, it is not clear where the label including FCC ID will be located on the device. Please provide a better Label and Location exhibit.
- 2.) FYI: Please note that I expect that the required compliance language of 15.19 (a)(1) on the outside of this device.
"This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the condition that this device does not cause harmful interference."
- 3.) The Manual does not provide any type of installation instructions. Therefore it is not possible for me to be sure that adequate RF Exposure warning or instructions will be provided to the end user or installer. Please provide installation instructions for this device.
- 4.) It is not acceptable to use the same document for Operational Description and for Manual. Please review and correct.
- 5.) You have asked for the Block Diagram to be held Confidential, but no Block Diagram is given. It is not possible to ask for Confidentiality treatment of any document that is not provided. You must either supply a corrected Confidentiality Request letter, or a Block Diagram. FYI: Block Diagrams are not required for Licensed transmitters under rule 2.1033(c).
- 6.) Please provide a Tune-Up specification for this device.
