








## TROUBLE-SHOOTING

### PROBLEM

Truck does not move or moves slowly

### POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- Make sure power switch on truck and transmitter control are in the "ON" position
- Make sure the battery in the truck and transmitter are installed properly
- Replace exhausted battery with new "9V" alkaline battery and recharge truck battery

Truck moves erratically or transmitter range is short

- Change locations as there may be radio interference in the area
- Move away from other radio-control trucks or gadgets as they may be operating on the same frequency
- Make sure antenna in transmitter is screwed in tight and fully extended
- Make sure transmitter battery connection is in good condition

Truck does not work after going through water, snow or sand

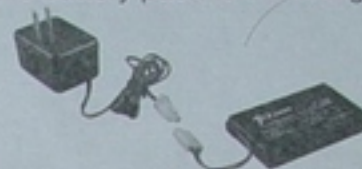
- Allow truck to dry thoroughly for 24 hours
- Avoid driving in water, snow or sand

## SAFETY PRE-CAUTIONS

- Do not operate during thunderstorms or rain.
- Avoid water, sand and snow when operating your truck.
- Do not submerge truck or controller in water.
- Never operate your truck on the street or highway.
- Never operate your truck in a confined or crowded area, and do not use people or animals as obstacles.
- Do not run your truck into furniture, objects or hard surfaces, as this will cause damage to both the objects and the truck.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires, gears and motor while the truck is switched to "ON".
- Do not leave truck or transmitter near sources of heat or under direct sunlight for long period of time.
- Do not leave truck or transmitter outside overnight. Dampness is harmful to interior components.
- Remove all batteries when not in use to avoid accidental operation.
- Adult supervision is recommended when operating this truck.

## CHARGING

1. Before first use, the rechargeable battery pack must be charged with the included special charging adapter plug for at least 10 hours.
2. Connect the plug end of the battery pack to the charging plug of the adapter as shown.



3. Plug the AC adapter into wall outlet (110V) and let it fully charged for at least 10 hours for the first time. Subsequent recharging requires approximately 6 - 7 hours.
4. DO NOT charge the rechargeable battery pack for more than 16 hours.

## RADIO-CONTROL TRANSMITTER SET-UP

1. Remove the screw on the back of the transmitter from the battery compartment cover with the provided screwdriver.
2. Remove the cover and insert the included 9V battery in the correct polarity as shown in the battery compartment.
3. Replace the cover and tighten the screw.
4. Attach the antenna to the top of the transmitter by winding it clockwise until tight.

## STUNT MUSIC TRUCK SET-UP

1. Power must be in OFF position (truck underside) before connecting the rechargeable battery pack.
2. Rechargeable battery pack must be fully charged for at least 10 hours before first use.
3. Remove the two screws from the chrome color panel behind the truck cab.
4. Connect the rechargeable battery pack to the battery plug inside the battery compartment. Attach the two plug ends securely.
5. Insert the rechargeable battery pack into the battery compartment.
6. Replace the chrome color panel and screws securely.

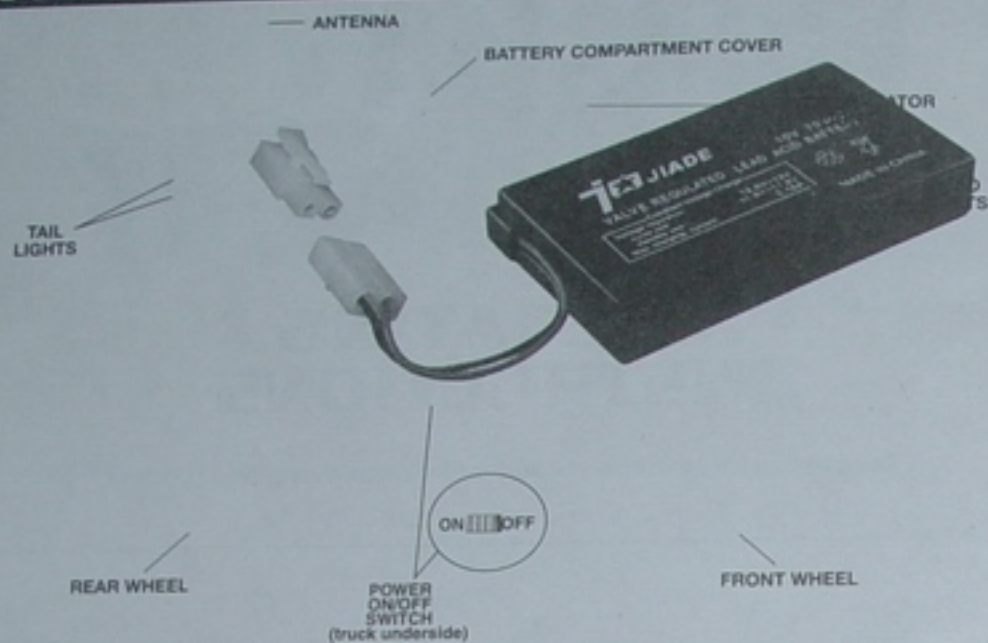

## OPERATION

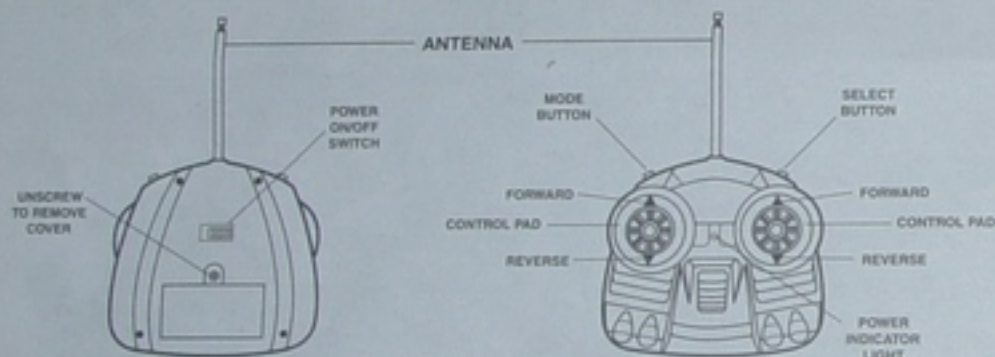
1. Turn the music truck on by switching the power to ON (truck underside). Red color power indicator light on the top of the truck will appear.
2. Switch the radio-control unit to ON (transmitter underside). Red color power indicator light lit on the front.
3. Press SELECT button once to start up the truck and hear the ignition and engine idle sounds.
4. Press SELECT button to alternate between the 2 horn sounds.
5. Press MODE button to enter into Music/Song mode. Press SELECT to cycle between the two programmed classic rock songs ("Born to be Wild" and "Gimme All Your Lovin").
6. Press MODE button again to turn off all sounds; other functions remain.

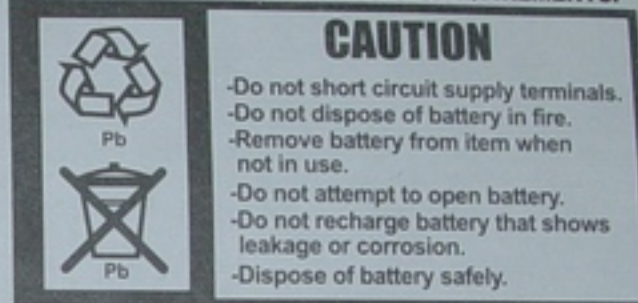

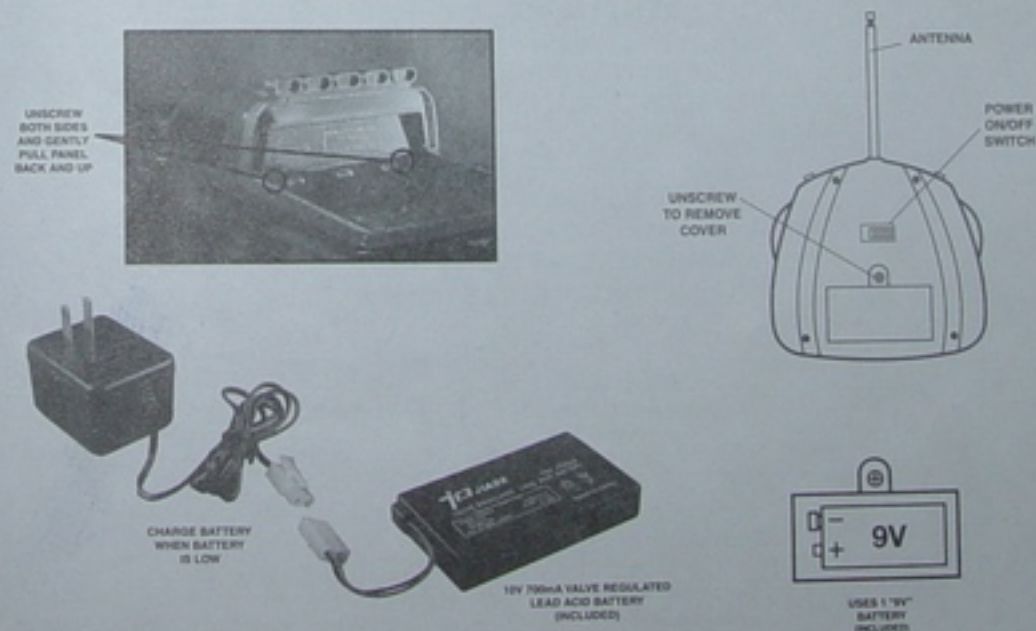
## BATTERY PRE-CAUTION
