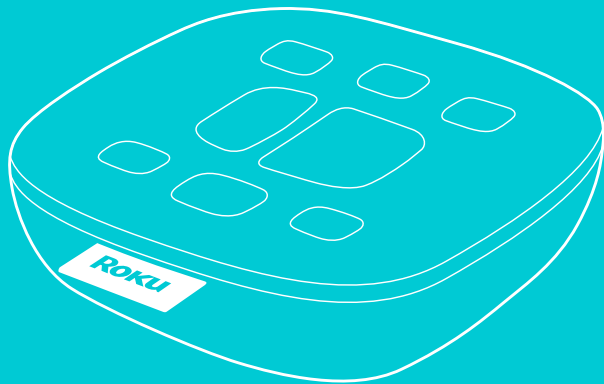

Meet your new Roku Touch

Top view



Pair - Press to pair to your Roku device.

Microphone button - Press and hold while saying a command.

Programmable presets

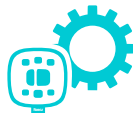
To set: Give a command using the microphone button. Then, press and hold a preset button until you hear a tone.

To use a saved command: Press the button once.



1. Prepare to pair

- Turn on your Roku TV™.
- Using your existing remote, press and hold  for 5 seconds to get to the pairing menu.
- Select **Remote**.



2. Set it up

- Insert the batteries into your Roku Touch.
- Press and hold the pair button for 5 seconds.
- The TV will automatically begin pairing.
