



Differences of the RC03 and RC04 models

RC03 and RC04 RF remote control models are mechanically and electrically identical except that RC03 contains audio codec IC (U11) and several additional passive components needed for its proper operation, as well as it's equipped with a 3.5mm audio jack for headset connection. For more details please see the figure below.
