After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) The updated users manual does mention RF exposure information, however because the device is mobile, it should clearly explain to the user the minimum distance requirements. Typically this is done using the following or similar statements:

“To comply with FCC RF exposure compliance requirements, the antenna used for this transmitter must be installed to provide a separation distance of at least 20 cm from all persons and must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter”.

- 2) Users manual page 23-labeled 20 appears to show a maximum output power of 100 mW, much higher than the measured 68 mW (maximum conducted power measured). Please review, explain, and correct as necessary.
