#### 1.1. Limits

Friis Formula

Friis transmission formula: Pd = (Pout\*G)/(4\*pi\*r2)

Where

Pd = power density in mW/cm2

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

R = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd id the limit of MPE, 1 mW/cm2. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.



#### 1.2. Test Procedure

Software provided by client enabled the EUT to transmit and receive data at lowest, middle and highest channel individually.

The temperature and related humidity: 18°C and 78% RH.

So according to transmission formula:  $Pd = (Pout*G)/(4*pi*r^2)$  and the power density limit according to KDB 447498D01V06 and FCC Part1.1310(b), the limit is  $1mW/cm^2$ 

## **Safety Distance Calculation Formula:**

The power flux:

$$S = \frac{P^*G_{(\theta,\phi)}}{4^*\pi^*r^2}$$

So safety distance as following:

$$r = \sqrt{\frac{P * G}{4 * \pi * S}}$$

P = input power of the antenna

G = antenna gain relative to an isotropic antenna

 $\theta$ ,  $\Phi$  = elevation and azimuth angles.

r = distance from the antenna to the point of investigation

Note: The safety distance is 5.34 for 300Mbps Wireless N Mini Router without any other radio equipment.

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
