Gentlemen:

We, Houston Radar, request that the **schematic diagrams, system block diagrams, operational descriptions and internal photos** submitted with the application for certification for TIASS300 be withheld from public disclosure as per Section 0.459 of FCC Rules. This request is made under the provisions of Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's Rules, and Section 552(b) (4) of the Freedom of Information Act. These sections authorize as a withholding from public inspection, material which would be privileged as a matter of law if retained by the person submitting them, and material which would not customarily be released to the public by that person. The material contains technical data, which would customarily be guarded from competitors.

Additionally we request that the internal photos be kept confidential because our product is typically installed on poles inside traffic speed signs and not accessible to the general public, but by a technician. The general public therefore does not have access to an internal view of our product.
