You asked:

1. Please provide measurement data to show compliance with a frequency hopping transmitter as required by FCC Public Notice DA 00-705, March 2000.

The frequency hopping spread spectrum transmitter in the Remington Eyeball unit (an Aerocomm AC4490 system) is an integral subassembly and is not modified. Therefore Remington relies on Aerocomm's FCC certification of that device. AeroComm's FCC ID is KQC-AC4490. The AeroComm device certification file is available at

2. Please provide an RF exposure statement as required by FCC Rules section 15.247(e)(i).

We suspect that a typo crept in here. Our copy of 15.247(e) does not contain an RF exposure statement requirement. The unit is categorically excluded from routine environmental evaluation for RF exposure prior to equipment authorization or use under 2.1093(c) because it is a mobile unit with total emitted power less than 3 watts.
