2. Obey traffic laws at all times. Make sure that using a Bluetooth wireless headset while driving is permitted by your local law.

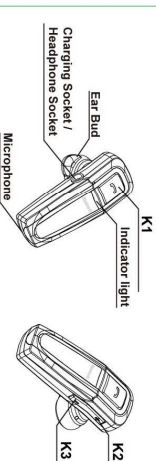

Getting Started

- To use your Bluetooth Stereo Headset, please follow these simple steps:
- Charge your headset
- Pair your headset with a Bluetooth-enabled mobile handset

Your headset overview



K1 Button: Turn on/ Turn off/ Pairing/ Answer/ End/ Voice Dial/ Reject/ Transferring a call/ Redial

K2 Button: Increase Volume/Next song

K3 Button: Decrease Volume/Previous song

K2 Button & K3 Button: Muting the microphone

K1&K2 Button : Play / Pause / Stop music playing

Charging the headset

Your headset uses a rechargeable battery. You must charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time. Simply plug in provided USB cable to USB port then to USB Car Charger Adapter / Notebook Computer / Desktop Computer. Headset will start charging. The red indicator of headset will turn on when charging. When the battery is full, the red indicator of the headset will turn off.

Play the previous / next song

Hold and press K2 Button for 2 seconds while music is on to play the next song. Hold and press K3 Button for 2 seconds while music is on to play the previous song.

Stop music playing

Hold and press K1 and K2 Button at the same time for 2 seconds to stop music playing.

Storage of the headset

1. Always store the headset with the power off and make sure it is safely protected
2. Avoid storage at high temperatures (above 60°C), such as in a hot vehicle or in direct sunlight. (Storage at high temperatures can damage performance and reduces battery life.)
3. Do not expose the headset or any of its supplied parts to rain or other liquids

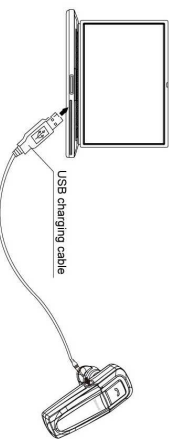

- 1) Charge the headset until the red light on the headset turn off.
- 2) The headset will be fully charged in approximately 1-2 hours.
- 3) Remove the USB cable from the charging socket.

IMPORTANT: The headset cannot be used while charging.



BASIC OPERATIONS

Turning the headset on/off

1. To turn the headset on: Press and hold K1 Button for about 3 seconds, the blue indicator of the headset flashes for 3 times. The headset is now turned on.

IMPORTANT: Once you turn on the headset again each time, there will be an auto-connecting between the headset and the mobile handset which is resumed. For pairing, please refer to "Pairing". Depend on your phone type, the actual operation may vary.

Pairing

2. To turn the headset off: Press and hold K1 Button for about 4 seconds, the red indicator flashes for 3 times, then off. The headset will be turned off.
3. When the blue indicator flashes red during standby mode, it means the headset is on low battery, please charge the headset.

Pairing will create a unique and encrypted wireless link between two Bluetooth enabled devices, such as your Bluetooth phone and Bluetooth headset.

1. Ensure that the headset is off (see "To turn the headset off" section).
2. Press and hold the K1 Button for about 5 seconds until the indicator light alternately flashes blue and red.
3. Set your Bluetooth phone to discover the headset by following your phone's guide. Typically, the steps involve going to a "Setup", "Connect", or "Bluetooth" menu on your phone and then selecting the option to discover Bluetooth devices.

4. Your phone will find the "BTK-308" headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this by pressing the "Yes" or "OK" key
5. Enter a passkey or PIN code "0000" (4 zeros), then press the "Yes" or "OK" key.

IMPORTANT: If the pairing can't be completed within 60 seconds while the pairing mode is activated, that means the pairing is unsuccessful. please repeat Step 1 to Step 5 to pair the headset and the mobile phone again.

Making a call

1. Dial number on the keypad or select the contact name from the contact list of your mobile phone.
2. Press phone's "send/call" key.

Voice Dialing

Please ensure your mobile phone supports voice dialing function and the voice tag assigned for this feature.

1. If your mobile support this function, shortly press K1 Button once.
2. You'll then hear the voice-activation tone, say the name of the person you wish to call.
3. Shortly press K1 Button to stop the voice dialing.

Note: 1. For the mobile phone which don't support voice dialing function, shortly press the K1 button once will redial the last number.

2. Depend on your phone type, the actual operation may vary.

Ending a call

1. Shortly press K1 Button once during a call.
2. End a call from phone's keypad.

Answering a call

1. Press the K1 button briefly, when you receiving an incoming call.
2. Answer the call via your phone's keypad. You may then need to transfer the call to the headset by pressing the K1 Button for 2 seconds (depending on your phone setting).

Last number redialing

Shortly press K1 button twice to make the last number redial. For the mobile phone which don't support voice dialing function, shortly press the K1 button once will redial the last number.

Note: Depend on your phone type, the actual operation may vary.

Rejecting an incoming call

Hold and press K1 for 2 seconds to reject a call.

Adjusting the volume
Press K2 Button to increase the volume level and press K3 Button to decrease the volume level.

Transferring a call

Headset to phone: Press and hold K1 Button for 2 seconds when you hear a melody, release it.
Phone to Headset: Press and hold K1 Button for 2 seconds when you hear a melody, release it.

Note: For different mobile phone setting, you could only transfer a call by using the mobile phone's keypad. Depend on your phone type, the actual operation may vary.

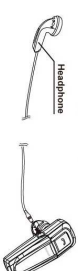
Muting the microphone

You can put a call on hold by muting the microphone. To turn off the Muting Microphone: Press the K2 Button and K3 Button at the same time. To turn on the Muting Microphone: Press the K2 Button and K3 Button at the same time. There is a beep every 3 seconds.

Additional Operations

Important: Below functions are only applicable to mobile handset with Bluetooth Handsfree Profile. Functionality varies depending on the mobile handset model you have. Please refer to your mobile handset user guide for additional information.

You can enjoy high quality stereo music by using this stereo Bluetooth headset suing with additional 3.5 mm jack earphone



Play

Shortly press K1 and K2 Button at the same time while being connected to your Bluetooth audio device. Shortly press K1 and K2 Button at the same time while the music is stopped. The music automatically comes back after you ended a call if you answered a call while listening to music

PAUSE

Shortly press K1 and K2 Button at the same time while listening to music. Shortly press K1 and K2 Button at the same time again to listen to the song from the paused part.
