

In case of channel interference (either one or two of the microphones cannot be detected by the main player),

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the GRAND VIDEOKE.

- GRANDVIDEOKE is the first Perfect Score Karaoke in Philippines.
 You can check the details of your song after singing.
- The GRAND VIDEOKE provides various kinds of Moving Picture Background. (WOW Nature, World Tour, 3D Ani, Motion, K-POP M/V etc.)
- GRAND VIDEOKE provides additional high capacity internal memory, the GRAND VIDEOKE uses a high quality wireless microphone.
- This product plays five types of music content:
 - MIDI (Musical Instrument Digital Interface) music is music produced through a synthesizer to generate all the sounds of all instruments for a specific song.
 MIDI music is typical karaoke music. It rarely uses vocals.
 - Real Sound is a specially modified MP3 music for karaoke use developed by TJmedia.
 It is real orchestra music that lets you experience videoke singing with back up singers, second voice, orchestra accompaniment such as real string instruments.
 - Multiplex is songs with vocals.
 - Chorus is a group of persons singing in unison.
 - MTV is original music video with original singer's voice.
- The remote control included in the package makes this product more convenient to use.
- The alphanumeric keypads of the remote control and microphone make it easy for you to find your favorite songs even if you remember only the song title or the first name of the artist.
- The GRAND VIDEOKE has the capability to reserve up to 100 songs.
- The GRAND VIDEOKE has a Favorite Songs function that saves your favorite songs even after the unit is turned off. Any song included in this list is automatically saved.



How To Use The Kevs

The keypad of the GRAND VIDEOKE is an alphanumeric keypad similar to your cell phone. With the GRAND VIDEOKE keypad you can key-in letters into the screen when searching for songs.

The (b) in the GRAND VIDEOKE Microphone is used to power on the Microphone, while the on POWER on the GRANDVIDEOKE is used to turn the GRANDVIDEOKE on and off.

How to take care of your GRAND VIDEOKE

- 1. Do not attempt to open the GRAND VIDEOKE. This will void the warranty.
- Use only the adaptor included with your GRAND VIDEOKE. Using other adaptors could cause serious damage to this device and thereby void the warranty.
- Do not cover the product or any of its accessories while the GRAND VIDEOKE is turned on. Always allow air to move freely around the GRAND VIDEOKE and the microphone
- in order to prevent overheating.4. Avoid bending or twisting the cord.
- 5. Do not place heavy or sharp objects on top of the cable to prevent punctures or cuts
- 6. Do not put this device near an object containing water (such as a vase) to avoid damage or electric shock. In case water or any liquid substance enters the unit, immediately unplug the power cord, then bring your WOW Videoke Premium to the nearest dealer or service center to check for damage and for repair, if necessary.
- Do not place the product on an unstable surface, near flammable substances, under direct sun light, or in a wet and dusty place.
- In order to prevent malfunctions, do not place the product near devices that generate strong electric & magnetic fields such as transformers, mobile phones, back portion of TV's, etc.
- 9. Make all the necessary connections before powering up the GRAND VIDEOKE.
- 10. Make sure to place the batteries of the remote control in the correct polarity to prevent possible damage to the remote control.

Maintenance & Cleaning of your GRAND VIDEOKE

- During thunderstorms, do not use the product and unplug the adaptor from the wall socket.
- 2. If you will not use the product for a long time, unplug the adaptor.
- Do not use strong solvents (such as alcohol/benzene/thinner) to clean the product. This could damage the product's paint work; use only cloth dampened with water and mild detergent.
- 4. Before cleaning or moving the device, unplug the adaptor.












Nomenclature (Remote Control)

To avoid electric discharge or damage of battery:

- When putting the batteries in the remote control, check its poles (+/-).
- Make sure that you use AAA size of batteries.
- When changing the batteries, change both batteries at the same time.
- If you will not use the device for a long time, take the batteries out of remote control.

When to change the batteries(2 x AAA Batteries)

 If the remote control does not work even within a short distance from the main player, the batteries need to be changed.

How to change the batteries:



1. Please push down and pull up to uncover.



2. Insert the batteries correctly.



3. Close the cover.



Search song and reserve by remote-control and control buttons on Mic

Be sure to read the introduction on the "How to use the keys" section found at the beginning of this manual.

Unified Search Screen-Title or Artist



In this figure, Blue Submarine is "highlighted", you can reserve it by pressing (∞) , move the (Δ) , (Δ) keys to highlight and reserve more songs.

- 1. Title/Artist this is the current Sort mode, to change press [VOL].
- 2. Song numbers index number of the song in GRAND VIDEOKE songbook.
- 3. Type Indicates the type of this song.
- 4. 0005/0011 Current Page over Total number of pages for the whole GRAND VIDEOKE HD library.

If you add a new song, the total number of pages will change accordingly.

- 5. Search input box. (Enter a title or artist name.)
- 6. Favorite symbol this song has been added in the Favorite list.



Selecting Songs by Title or Artist

- 1. Press (SEL) to enter the Unified Search function.
- 2. The search function contains the list of songs available on the GRAND VIDEOKE.
- Key-in the equivalent text character(s) of the song title or Artist you're looking for. As you enter the first letters of the song title or Artist, the songs with the same beginning letters appear also in the screen.
 - Continue to key-in letters until your song comes up on the screen.
- Press ▲ ▼ to scroll to the song title or Artist you want to select. If the title or Artist
 is not visible on the current screen, press {left/right} to move to the next or to the
 previous page.
- Press (Res) to reserve the highlighted song.
- Simply follow the procedure above to add more songs to the reservation list. You can reserve a maximum of 100 songs.
- 7. Songs in the reservation list are erased once the GRAND VIDEOKE is turned off.
- 8. If you want to make a list of songs that is retained even after the unit is turned off, please see instructions regarding the "Favorite Menu".
- 9. In case you made an error, you can cancel the previously reserved song by pressing (C).
- 10. If you are ready to play the songs you selected, press C until the search disappears from the screen. Then press (S).
- During playback, you can still press es to access the search function in order to reserve additional songs. However, during playback, the search will be smaller and will display a list of five (5) titles at a time. Press
 - ◀, ► to move from page to page.

Reservation

- The song reserved is displayed on your monitor.
- The GRAND VIDEOKE plays the reserve songs one after the other, the user doesn't need to press (\$\oldsymbol{S}\) button to play each reserved song.
- You can cancel the reserved songs by pressing C.
- If you key-in the reserved song number and press the button, you can cancel the song.



Play, Pause, Stop

Play

- To play a song, select from the list on the screen and press sto on the microphone or in the remote control.
- You can also select the song in the song list. Use the arrow key ◀.►, ▲,▼
 and press(⑤) to play.
- Once you finish singing, your score will be shown on the display.
- If a Real Sound song is playing, the 'REAL' icon will be displayed as shown left.
- If a Multiplex song is playing, the 'Multiplex' icon will be displayed as shown left.
- If a Chorus song is playing, the 'Chorus' icon will be displayed as shown left.
- If a MTV song is playing, the 'MTV' icon will be displayed as shown left.
- If a Duet song is playing, the 'DUET' icon will be displayed as shown left.

Pause

- If you want to pause the song for a while, press (5) to pause.
- Press (5) to start again.

Stop

• Press to stop the playing.

Music Volume / Mic Volume / Echo

Music, Mic, and echo levels can be adjusted by pressing.

However when the menus and search screen are on display, you cannot use to adjust the music, mic, echo volume; you have to exit to the main screen by pressing. It is best to pause the songs by pressing to make any adjustment so that it does not interfere with your singing.

Music Volume Control

- Press to adjust the music volume level.
- When the music volume bar is displayed on top of the screen, you can adjust the volume level using the arrow keys ◀.▶.

MIC Volume Control

- Press 🚾 2 times to adjust MIC volume level.
- When the MIC volume bar is displayed on the top of the screen, you can adjust the MIC volume level using the arrow keys

 ▼

Echo Volume Control

- Press 3 times to adjust ECHO volume level.
- When the echo volume bar is displayed on the top of the screen, you can adjust the echo volume level using the arrow keys

 , ▶.



Melody / Tempo adjustment / Key adjustment

Melody, key, and tempo can only be adjusted when a song is playing. However, when the menus and search screen are on display, you cannot use (a) to adjust melody, key, and tempo; you have to exit to the main screen by pressing (a) until the menus or search screen disappear. It is best to pause the songs by pressing (a) to make any adjustment so that it does not interfere with your singing.

Melody

- Press (Au) until the Melody control bar appears.
- When the melody bar is displayed on the top of the screen, you can adjust melody volume level, using the arrow keys ◀,▶ Melody volume can be set 4 levels (None – Low – Middle – High).

- Press (AD) until the Temp control bar appears.
- Press the arrow key ◀,▶ and adjust the tempo level.
- Tempo can be set from -6 level to +6 level.

Key

- Press auntil the Key control bar appears.
- Press the arrow key ◀,▶.
- Key can be set from -6 level to +6 level.
- These controls are only available while the unit is playing.

Skip Menu

The Skip function allows the user to skip the current prelude (instrumental, intro, interlude) line, or verse. This function can be compared to the fast forward or rewind in music players.

- Press while playing, and select the arrow key
 to skip BAR.
 Skipping the bar lets you move to the next line of lyrics.
- Press while playing, and select the arrow key to skip BAR. Skipping the bar lets you move to the previous line of lyrics.
- Press
 Own while playing, and select the arrow key ▼ to skip VERSE.

The Skip function may vary from each song to song. It is best to use Skip "Prelude" and "Bar", because some songs have long verses or are not divided according to verse and skipping the verse might end the song.



To access menu functions & configuration settings, press {menu}. You can navigate through the menu items by pressing ◀.▶. ▲.▼. To enter a menu function, press (sea

Search Menu

Please see portion regarding "Search Screen" "Search Function, Song Reservation".

Favorite Menu

The Favorite Songs list contains user selected songs that are stored in the GRAND VIDEOKE's memory. This list is retained even after the GRAND VIDEOKE is turned off.



To add songs to the favorite list:

- To register your favorite song, select a song search screen and press (MENU)
- A {STAR} icon will be added in behind the artist, which means the song is in your favorite folder. If you press again, the {STAR} icon will disappear and the song is removed from the favorite folder.

Managing the favorite list:

- In your favorite song list, you can sort the songs in terms of the song title or artist. If you want to remove a song in the list, select a song and press www.
- Press S to play a song from the Favorite Songs list.
- You can also reserve the songs in your favorite list to cue them to play, just highlight the song and press s.
- You can sort your favorite songs by Title and Artist press to change the sort mode.



Record Menu

The record function allows the user to record his/her song.

Both the instrumentals and the user's voice are recorded and be played back.

Recorded songs are stored in the GRAND VIDEOKE's built-in memory.

Recorded time is up to 5 mins per a song. If exceeded, It's not properly recorded.

To use the recording shortcut: from the search screen, highlight a song and press (mc) until the recording is activated, or you can use the Record Menu.

- Press (MENU), and select "REC"
- Select "Recording Song".
- Select the song, and press (s) to record.
- As recording starts, the recording symbol is displayed on the screen.
- After recording, you can see the recorded song list on the "Listen/Download", and play the recorded songs.
- Select the recorded song, and press (5) to play.

Repeat Menu

You can select any of the repeat functions as follows;

- {None}: Plays the reserved songs in order of reservation.
- {Continue}: Plays the reserved songs repeatedly.
- {All}: Plays all songs in order of song number repeatedly.

RPERFECT PITCH

The 'Perfect Pitch' feature allows you to check the beat and pitch in real time with enjoying the singing as a game.

- GAME MODE: Select from SINGLE / BATTLE mode.
- PLAY TIMES: Select the number of songs to be singing once, twice or three times (Only 'Battle mode').
 - * 'Select song ► Play' is repeated until 'Perfect Pitch' function is finished in 'Single Mode'.
- CHARACTERS: Selects from four characters or one of your photos as the character of the user.
- RANKING CHART: Displays the ranking of singers singing in SINGLE mode.
 The record is retained even when the device is turned off and on.
- HELP: Simple manual of the Perfect Pitch feature.
- START: After selecting mode for play such as Play Times, Character, then, you can be select the song.
- EXIT : Terminating features.

MTV/ Multiplex/ RealSound/ Chorus/ Duet Menu

- This menu provides the list of special kinds of songs.
- If you select an item, a relative list will be displayed.



Configuration Menu

The Configuration menu enables you to change some of the settings of the GRAND VIDEOKE like lyrics alignment, difficulty level of the scoring. Here is the list of the default values for each configuration option.

To change any of the configuration options, highlight it by pressing \blacktriangleleft . \blacktriangleright . \blacktriangle . \blacktriangledown then press \blacktriangle . \blacktriangledown to change the values until your desired value is displayed. When you're done with the change the value, press $(\lnot \blacksquare)$. To exit the menu screen press (\blacksquare) once.

Sound Setup

- To adjust the master volume, microphone 1/2 gain, equalizer and echo control, press the song number, then press (5) button.
- If you want to adjust without song, press C button to adjust.
- It is available to adjust the volume of each microphone.
 - Microphone 1: It is available to adjust both of the first wireless microphone and wired dynamic microphone.
 - Microphone 2: It is available to adjust both of the second wireless microphone and wired dynamic microphone.



Rutton Effect

When enabled, it makes a sound whenever a button is pressed.

Score check

This selects the scoring difficulty level.

Lyric Array

 Lyric Array allows the two lines of the lyrics to be aligned either to the center or to the left and right.

TV Setup

Switches the GRAND VIDEOKE's video format between NTSC and PAL.

How to use your Photos or Videos which is saved in USB Memory as background.

- 1. Save the photo or video file you want to use as background to USB memory.
- 2. Please insert your USB memory to the front side USB port, only.
- Press the MIC button or button on the remote control to select "Ext.Photo" will display your pictures in USB memory as the background.
- If you select "Ext.Video" in the same way, your video in USB memory will be displayed as background.
- Pictures in the USB memory will not be displayed as background when you remove the USB memory from the player.

How to use your photos which is saved in your player as a background.

- 1. Install the USB memory with your personal pictures.
- Press the mic www button >
 "USER" or the user button on the remote control to select the "Ext.Photo".
- 3. ◀,▶ Move the highlight by the direction key, and press the set button when highlights placed the picture you want to use as background.
- 4. When you have finished selecting pictures, press the button to save the selected picture to the player.
- Your photos in the player will be displayed as a background when you select "My.Photo" in the background category.
- Pictures in the player can be deleted from the "USER" ► "My.photo" menu, and deleted pictures are not displayed in the background.



Troubleshooting Guide

- The GRAND VIDEOKE does not turn on.
 - a. Make sure that the DC output plug of the adaptor is firmly plugged to the unit, and that its AC input plug is likewise firmly plugged into the AC outlet.
 - b. Please turn on the power.
- 2. The screen displays video but there is no sound.
 - a. Check if a headphone is connected to the TV, the amplifier(or speaker system) or the main player, and if so, disconnect the headphone.
 - b. Increase the volume of TV or amplifier. (or speaker system)
 - c. Also increase the volume of main player.
 - d. If the main player is connected to the HD TV, check if the HD Output cable is connected to the HD terminal between TV and main player properly.

 If there is no speaker system into TV or main player is connected to the normal TV, check if the red and white RCA cable is connected between TV(or amplifier) and main player properly.
- 3. The screen does not display video.
 - a. If the main player is connected to the HDTV, check if the HD Output cable is connected to the HD terminal between TV and main player properly. If the main player is connected to the normal TV, check if the yellow RCA cable is connected between TV and main player properly.
- 4. The volume of the MIC is low.
 - a. Press the {vol} button then press {right} button to increase the volume of the mic.
- 5. Real time score is displayed even if there is no person singing on the MIC.
 - a. Realtime score is designed to respond even to soft sounds, which includes surrounding noise.
- 6. The Main Unit does not turn off even after turning off the MIC.
 - a. The power switch of the MIC is designed to turn off the MIC. It does not control the power of the main unit.
 - b. Please turn off the power with the main unit's power switch.
- 7. Distance of the remote control is short.

The remote control does not operate well.

- a. Check battery of the remote control.
- b. Is the product being used near a strong light source (direct ray of light or bright electric lights)? Avoid bright light sources as much as possible.
- c. Remove any obstruction between the remote control and the main unit.



Q&A-Other

- 1. How do you set the TV mode?
 - Alternatively, you can select between NTSC and PAL. Enter the [Config] Menu, then enter [TV Setup] then select either NTSC or PAL.
- 2. How to use wired microphone.
 - It is available to use wired microphone in case that wireless microphone is defective or lost.
 - If you using wireless microphone 1, please use wired microphone through MIC 2 on the main unit.
 - If you using wireless microphone 2, please use wired microphone through MIC 1 on the main unit.
 - Also, it is available to adjust the volume of microphone in the menu of configuration as below Config → Sound → MIC Setup → "GAIN MIC1/2".
