

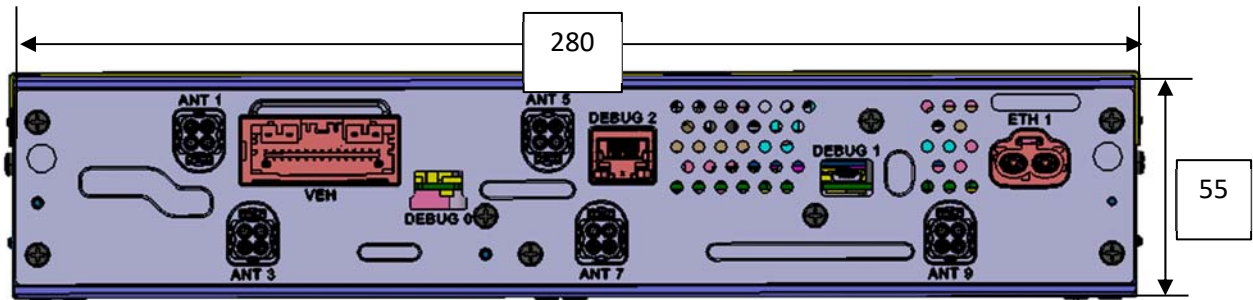

Each module will be connected one or two carriers so telematics unit can secure enough throughput and reliable connection to the internet. Only one type of LTE module will be mounted on the device via internal USB communication.
