The purpose of this letter is to clarify the placement of the security plate and FCC label on the updated L1 Identity Solutions B5000-B product (FCC ID TSP0B5000B).

The label is part of the security plate that also prevents the user from accessing the lens and camera alignment & focus screws. It is held in place with four "security"-type screws. This is the same method that was used for the previously-accepted unit (FCC ID TSP0B5000A) several years ago.
