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# 2.2 Test Mode

The EUT has been associated with peripherals and configuration operated in a manner tended to maximize its emission characteristics in a typical application. Frequency range investigated: radiation emission (9 kHz to the 10th harmonic of the highest fundamental frequency or to 40 GHz, whichever is lower). For radiated measurement, pre-scanned in three orthogonal panels, X, Y, Z. The worst cases (Y plane) were recorded in this report, and the worst mode of radiated spurious emissions is Bluetooth 3Mbps mode, and recorded in this report.

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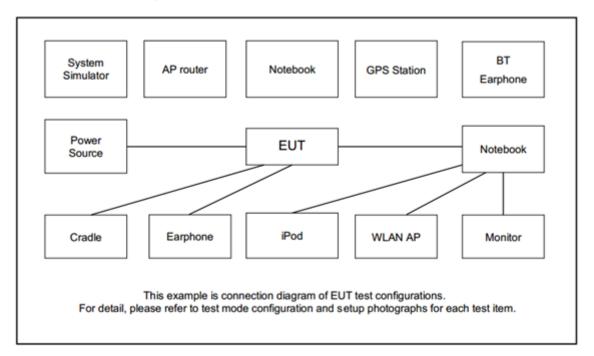

**Remark:** For radiated test cases, the worst mode data rate 3Mbps was reported only since the highest RF output power in the preliminary tests. The conducted spurious emissions and conducted band edge measurement for other data rates were not worse than 3Mbps, and no other significantly frequencies found in conducted spurious emission.

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# 2.4 EUT Operation Test Setup

The RF test items, utility "Blue Test3(3.3.2.368)" was installed in Notebook which was programmed in order to make the EUT get into the engineering modes to provide channel selection, power level, data rate and the application type and for continuous transmitting signals.

# 2.5 Measurement Results Explanation Example

### For all conducted test items:

The offset level is set in the spectrum analyzer to compensate the RF cable loss and attenuator factor between EUT conducted output port and spectrum analyzer. With the offset compensation, the spectrum analyzer reading level is exactly the EUT RF output level.

### Example:

The spectrum analyzer offset is derived from RF cable loss and attenuator factor.

Offset = RF cable loss + attenuator factor.

Following shows an offset computation example with cable loss 4.2 dB and 10dB attenuator.

Offset(dB) = RF cable loss(dB) + attenuator factor(dB). = 4.2 + 10 = 14.2 (dB)

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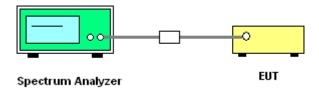

- 2. The RF output of EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 4. Enable the EUT hopping function.
- Use the following spectrum analyzer settings: Span = the frequency band of operation;
   RBW = 300kHz; VBW ≥ RBW; Sweep = auto; Detector function = peak; Trace = max hold.
- 6. The number of hopping frequency used is defined as the number of total channel.
- 7. Record the measurement data derived from spectrum analyzer.

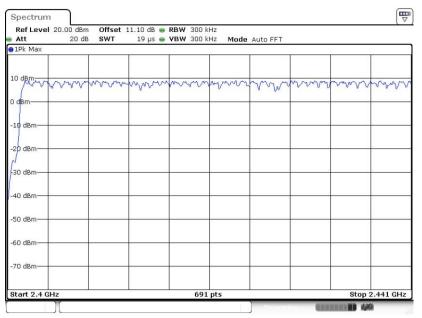

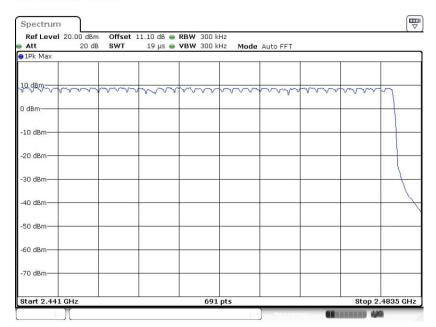

# 3.2.1 Limit of Hopping Channel Separation

Frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band may have hopping channel carrier frequencies that are separated by 25 kHz or two-thirds of the 20 dB bandwidth of the hopping channel, whichever is greater.

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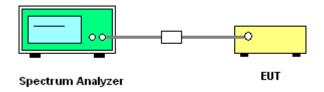

- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 4. Enable the EUT hopping function.
- Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:
   Span = wide enough to capture the peaks of two adjacent channels;
   RBW = 300kHz; VBW ≥ RBW; Sweep = auto; Detector function = peak; Trace = max hold.

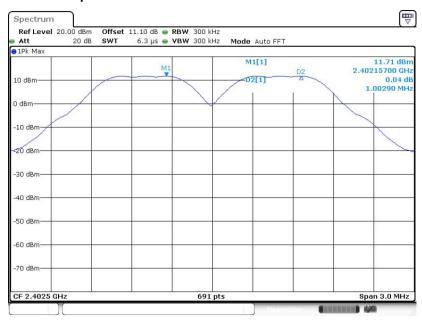

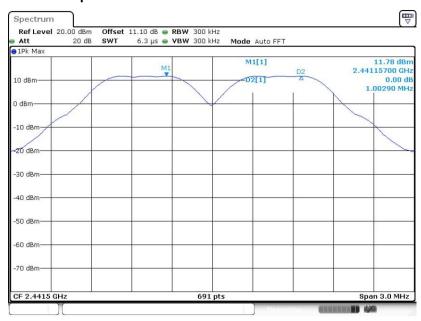
# Channel Separation Plot on Channel 00 - 01

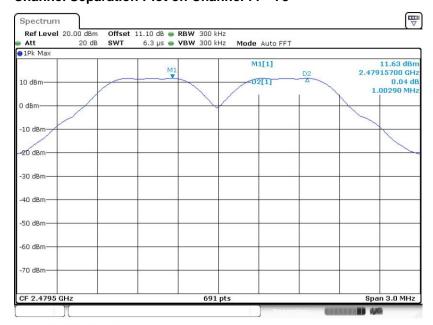
# **Channel Separation Plot on Channel 39 - 40**

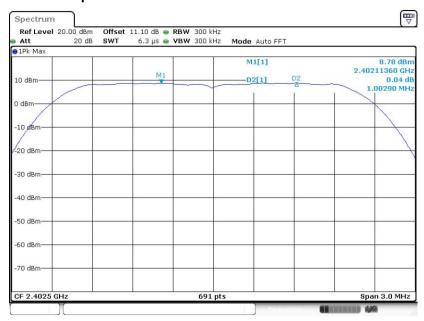

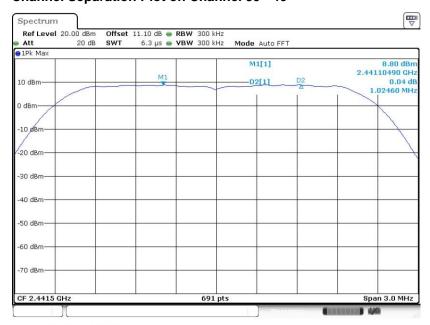
# Channel Separation Plot on Channel 00 - 01

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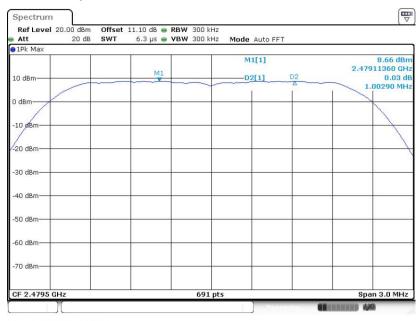

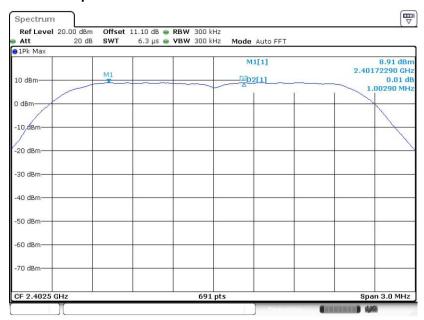

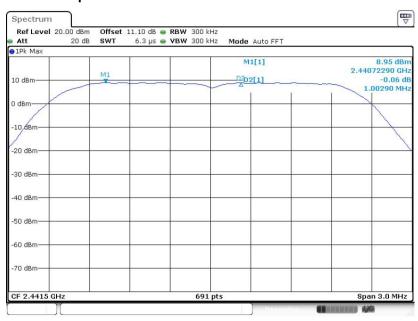
# Channel Separation Plot on Channel 00 - 01

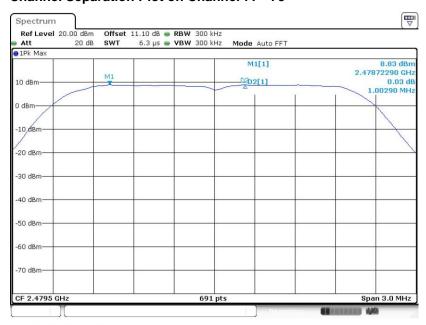

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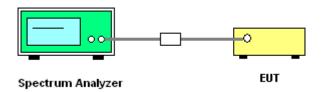

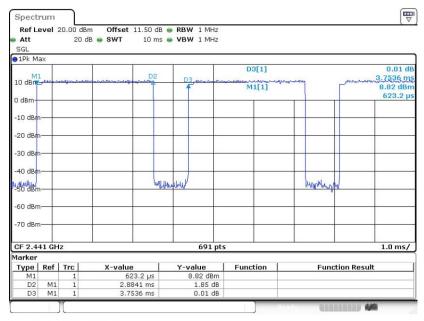

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# Remark:

- 1. In normal mode, hopping rate is 1600 hops/s with 6 slots in 79 hopping channels. With channel hopping rate (1600 / 6 / 79) in Occupancy Time Limit  $(0.4 \times 79)$  (s), Hops Over Occupancy Time comes to  $(1600 / 6 / 79) \times (0.4 \times 79) = 106.67$  hops.
- **2.** In AFH mode, hopping rate is 800 hops/s with 6 slots in 20 hopping channels. With channel hopping rate (800 / 6 / 20) in Occupancy Time Limit  $(0.4 \times 20)$  (s), Hops Over Occupancy Time comes to  $(800 / 6 / 20) \times (0.4 \times 20) = 53.33$  hops.

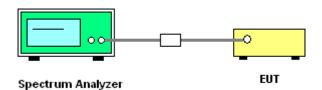

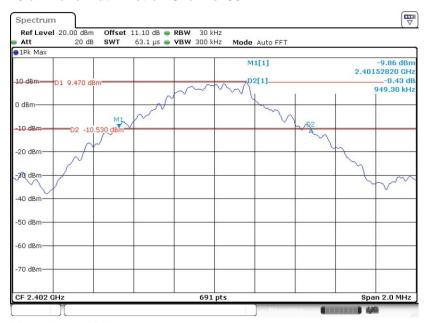

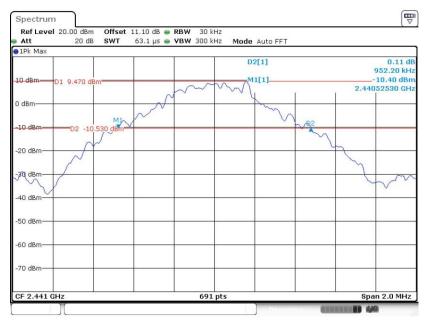
# 20 dB Bandwidth Plot on Channel 00



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# 20 dB Bandwidth Plot on Channel 39

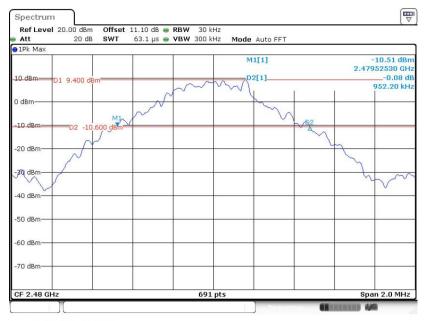

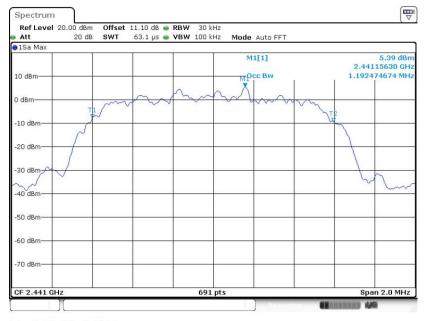
# 99% Occupied Bandwidth Plot on Channel 00

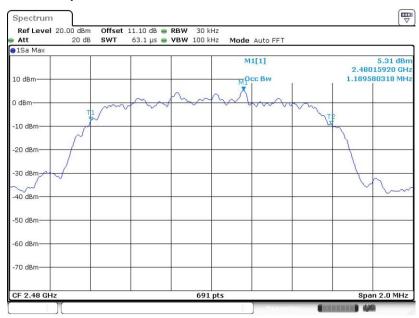

# 99% Occupied Bandwidth Plot on Channel 78

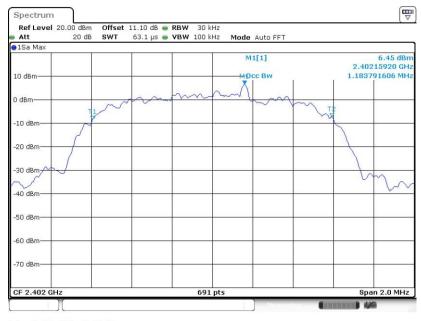

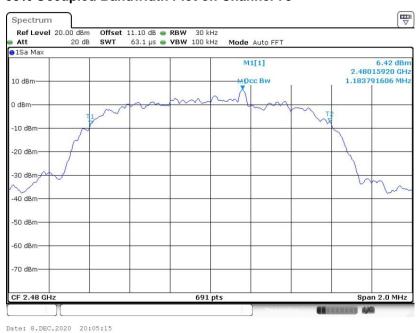
# 99% Occupied Bandwidth Plot on Channel 39

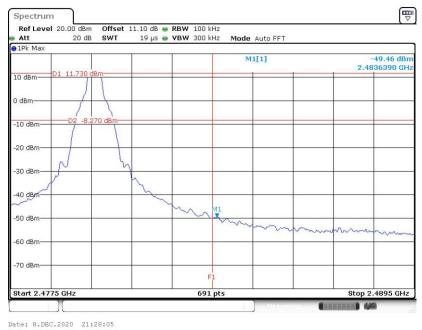
# Low Band Edge Plot on Channel 00

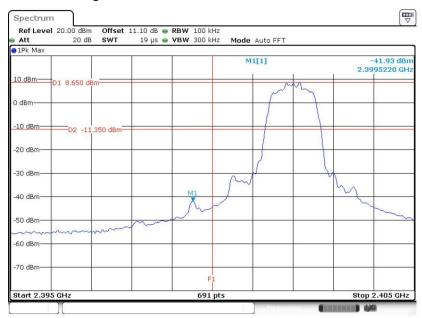
# **High Band Edge Plot on Channel 78**

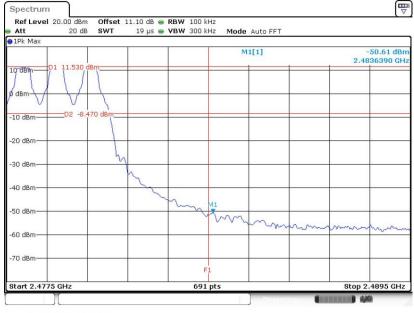
# **Hopping Mode Low Band Edge Plot**

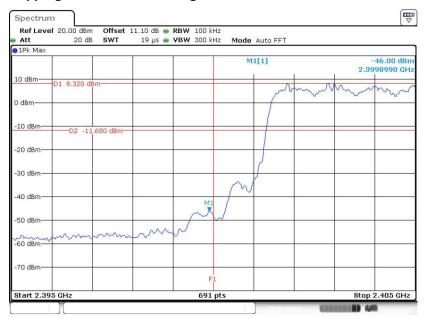

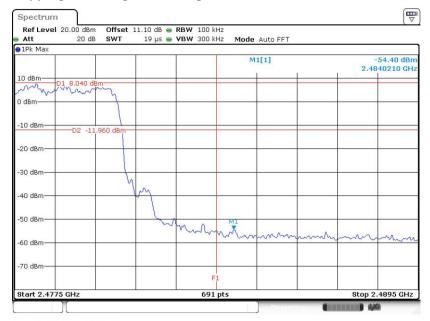
#### **Hopping Mode Low Band Edge Plot**

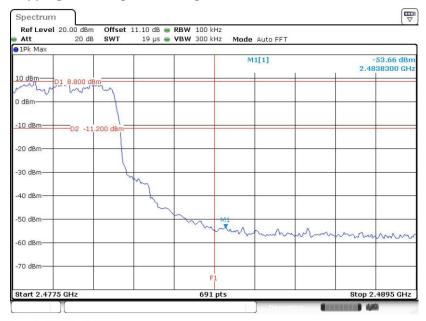

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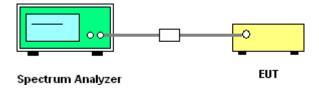

- 4. Set RBW = 100 kHz, VBW = 300kHz, scan up through 10th harmonic. All harmonics / spurs must be at least 20 dB down from the highest emission level within the authorized band as measured with a 100 kHz RBW.
- 5. Measure and record the results in the test report.
- 6. The RF fundamental frequency should be excluded against the limit line in the operating frequency band.

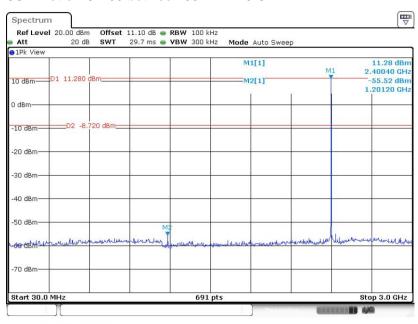

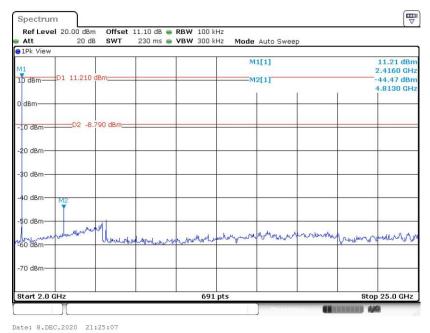
#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

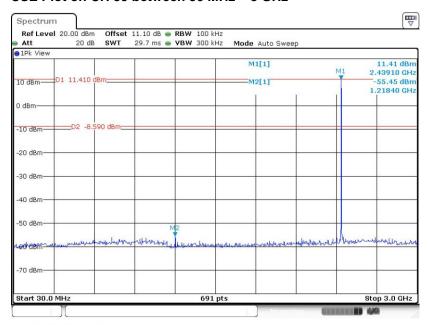

#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz



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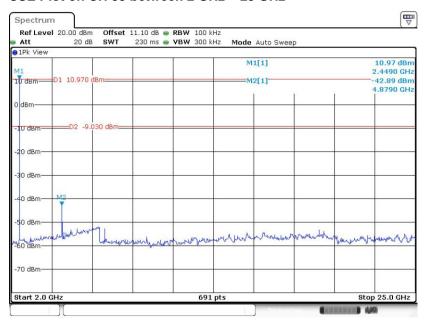
### CSE Plot on CH 39 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

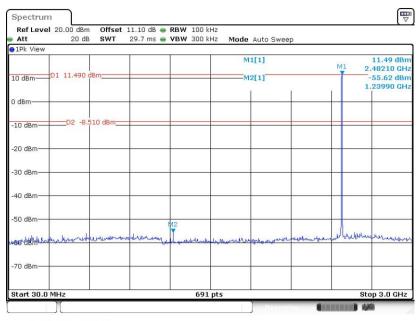

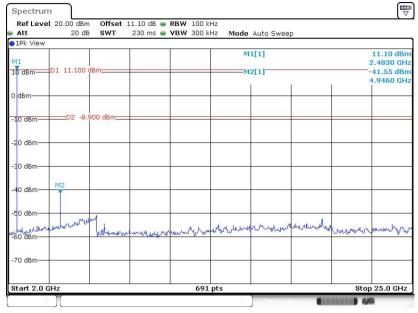
#### CSE Plot on CH 78 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

#### CSE Plot on CH 78 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

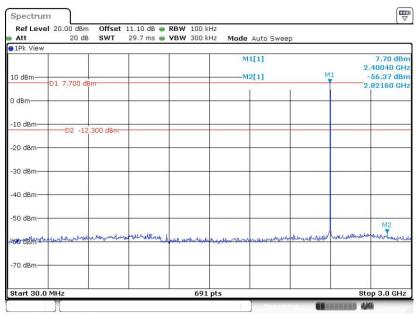

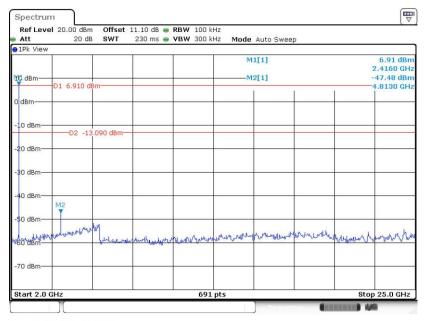
#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

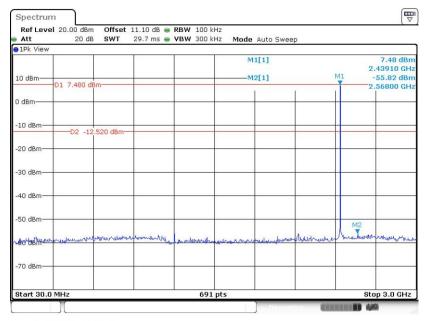
#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

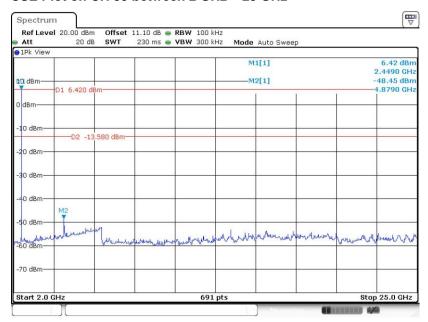
#### CSE Plot on CH 39 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

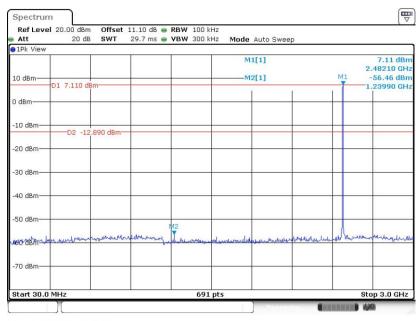
#### CSE Plot on CH 39 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

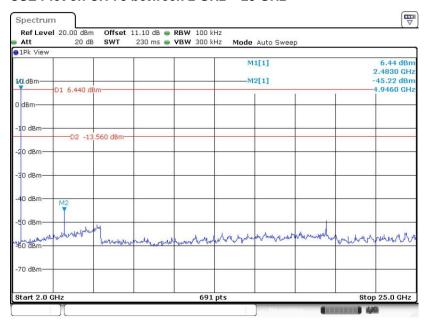
#### CSE Plot on CH 78 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

#### CSE Plot on CH 78 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

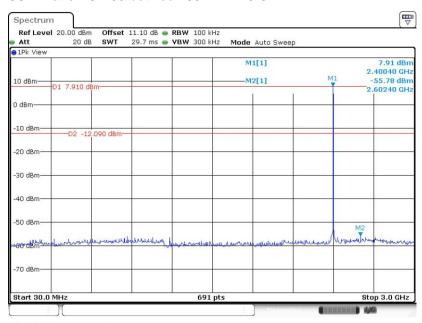

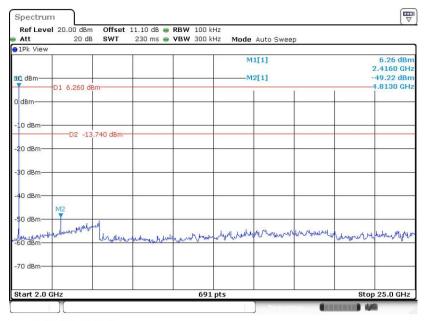
#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

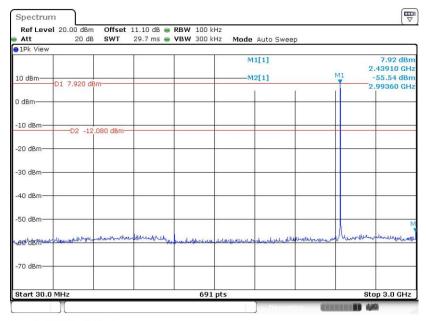
#### CSE Plot on CH 00 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

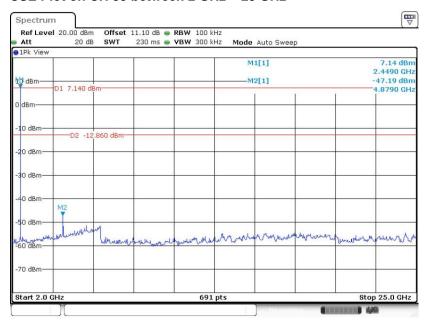
#### CSE Plot on CH 39 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

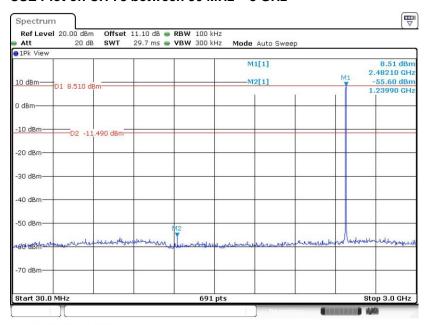
#### CSE Plot on CH 39 between 2 GHz ~ 25 GHz

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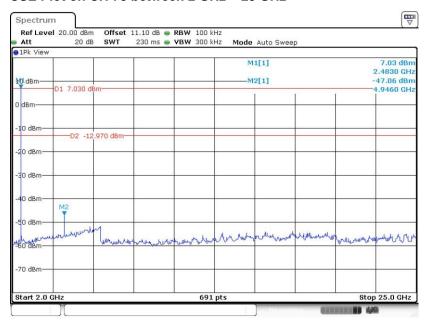
## CSE Plot on CH 78 between 30 MHz ~ 3 GHz

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## 3.8 Radiated Band Edges and Spurious Emission Measurement

### 3.8.1 Limit of Radiated Band Edges and Spurious Emission

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the intentional radiator frequency band, all harmonics/spurious must be at least 20 dB below the highest emission level within the authorized band. In addition, radiated emissions which fall in the restricted bands must also comply with the limits as below.

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#### 3.8.3 Test Procedures

1. The EUT was placed on a turntable with 0.8 meter for frequency below 1GHz and 1.5 meter for frequency above 1GHz respectively above ground.

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- 2. The EUT was set 3 meters from the interference receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable height antenna tower.
- 3. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then tune the Antenna tower (from 1 m to 4 m) and turntable (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading. A pre-amp and a high pass filter are used for the test in order to get better signal level to comply with the guidelines.
- 4. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 5. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:
  - (1) Span shall wide enough to fully capture the emission being measured;
  - (2) Set RBW=100 kHz for f < 1 GHz, RBW=1MHz for f>1GHz; VBW ≥ RBW; Sweep = auto; Detector function = peak; Trace = max hold for peak
  - (3) For average measurement: use duty cycle correction factor method per 15.35(c).

Duty cycle = On time/100 milliseconds

On time =  $N_1*L_1+N_2*L_2+...+N_{n-1}*LN_{n-1}+N_n*L_n$ 

Where  $N_1$  is number of type 1 pulses,  $L_1$  is length of type 1 pulses, etc.

Average Emission Level = Peak Emission Level + 20\*log(Duty cycle)

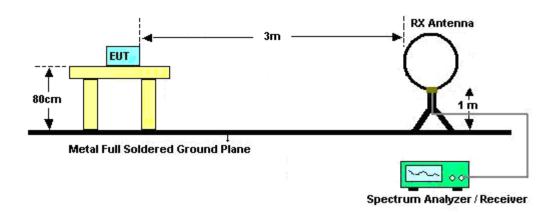
- 6. Corrected Reading: Antenna Factor + Cable Loss + Read Level Preamp Factor = Level
- 7. For testing below 1GHz, if the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 3 dB lower than the limit specified, then peak values of EUT will be reported, otherwise, the emissions will be repeated one by one using the CISPR quasi-peak method and reported.
- 8. For testing above 1GHz, the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 20dB lower than average limit (that means the emission level in average mode also complies with the limit in average mode), then peak values of EUT will be reported, otherwise, the emissions will be measured in average mode again and reported.

Note: The average levels were calculated from the peak level corrected with duty cycle correction factor (-24.76dB) derived from 20log (dwell time/100ms). This correction is only for signals that hop with the fundamental signal, such as band-edge and harmonic. Other spurious signals that are independent of the hopping signal would not use this correction.

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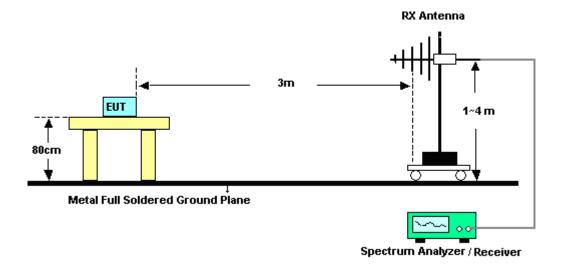

#### For radiated test below 30MHz



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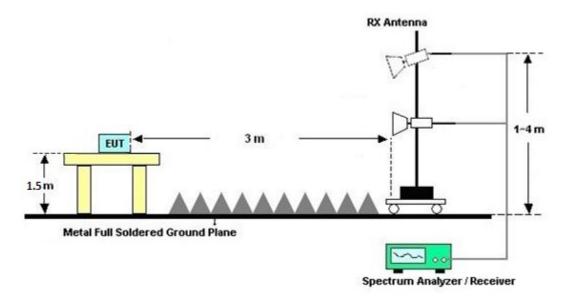
#### For radiated test from 30MHz to 1GHz



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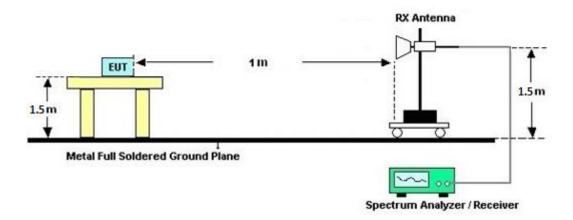


#### For radiated test from 1GHz to 18GHz

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#### 3.8.5 Test Results of Radiated Spurious Emissions (9 kHz ~ 30 MHz)

The low frequency, which started from 9 kHz to 30MHz, was pre-scanned and the result which was 20dB lower than the limit line was not reported.

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There is a comparison data of both open-field test site and alternative test site - semi-Anechoic chamber according to 414788 D01 Radiated Test Site v01r01, and the result came out very similar.

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## 3.9 Antenna Requirements

#### 3.9.1 Standard Applicable

If directional gain of transmitting antennas is greater than 6dBi, the power shall be reduced by the same level in dB comparing to gain minus 6dBi. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the rule.

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#### 3.9.2 Antenna Anti-Replacement Construction

An embedded-in antenna design is used.

#### 3.9.3 Antenna Gain

The antenna peak gain of EUT is less than 6 dBi. Therefore, it is not necessary to reduce maximum peak output power limit.

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## Appendix D. Duty Cycle Plots



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#### Note:

- 1. Worst case Duty cycle = on time/100 milliseconds =  $2 \times 2.89 / 100 = 5.78 \%$
- 2. Worst case Duty cycle correction factor = 20\*log(Duty cycle) = -24.76 dB
- 3. **3DH5** has the highest duty cycle worst case and is reported.

#### **Duty Cycle Correction Factor Consideration for AFH mode:**

Bluetooth normal hopping rate is 1600Hz and reduced to 800Hz in AFH mode; due to the reduced number of hopping frequencies, with the same packet configuration the dwell time in each channel frequency within 100msec period is longer in AFH mode than normal mode.

In AFH mode, the minimum hopping frequencies are 20, to get the longest dwell time DH5 packet is observed; the period to have DH5 packet completing one hopping sequence is

$$2.89 \text{ ms x } 20 \text{ channels} = 57.8 \text{ ms}$$

There cannot be 2 complete hopping sequences within 100ms period, considering the random hopping behavior, maximum 2 hops can be possibly observed within the period. [100 ms / 57.8 ms] = 2 hops Thus, the maximum possible ON time:

$$2.89 \text{ ms } x 2 = 5.78 \text{ ms}$$

Worst case Duty Cycle Correction factor, which is derived from the maximum possible ON time,

$$20 \times \log(5.78 \text{ ms}/100 \text{ ms}) = -24.76 \text{ dB}$$

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
