

RF exposure evaluation according to FCC CFR 47 part 15,  
§15.247(i)

The external pulse transmitter is a portable device.

No SAR evaluation required if a transmitter power is below the following threshold:

**Maximum measured transmitter power:**

P <sub>out</sub> conducted, mW	Maximum antenna gain, dBi	P <sub>out</sub> EIRP, mW
0.022	1.0	0.027

Threshold for no SAR evaluation is 24.2 mW, maximum measured Tx power is 0.022 mW – conducted and 0.027 mW- EIRP.

Conclusion: No SAR evaluation is required since the maximum transmitter output power, both conducted and radiated, is below the FCC threshold.
