To whom it may concern:

We, the undersigned, seek FCC approval of a Class II Permissive Change for the Speedway Revolution RFID Reader, Impinj model number IPJ-REV. The reason for the Class II change is a firmware upgrade to maintain 30 dBm conducted power referenced to the end of a cable with up to 1.5 dB of loss when operating the reader from a POE power source.

There are no hardware or mechanical changes to the reader; the product is unchanged from the previous version with the exception of the firmware upgrade to increase the output power at the reader's connector. The maximum conducted power to the antenna is unchanged as well as the maximum EIRP. The IPJ-REV currently requires professional installation. The reader is sold only to Impinj resellers or trained users
