I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) I accept your explanation that a DVD was used as a source for audio testing. However it does not completely satisfy the requirements of the Commission. Please look at the Manual for pages 12 for "Switching the Source" and the manual interconnection diagram on page 29 "System Connections". It appears that an external analog audio source (camcorder, video game or possibly CD player) can still be connected to this device. These audio input connections must be tested as well as internal DVD to assure that the emissions stay within the permitted bandwidth. Have these analog connections been tested and if so can you kindly provide the test results. For your reference I include the following guidelines from FCC to TCBs. Please remember to provide a complete description of the signal used to modulate the FM broadcast band fundamental:

"...Test labs should adjust the user tuning controls to ensure compliance. Check that the bandwidth complies when the transmitter is loaded at full audio input with a typical device e.g. CD player."

Check list: Use the General Checklist with the following frequent compliance issues.

- Check for a Bandwidth test with input at maximum.
- User controls or audio input adjusted to maximize emission for test.
