I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Kindly provide a Block Diagram for the transmitter section of this product.
- 2.) Please help identify the transmitter section within your internal photographs.
- 3.) Please provide a short description of the antenna used with this transmitter.
- 4.) Please show me where I can find the 15.21 statement within the Manual.
- 5.) It appears that your limit lines are incorrect on your radiated plots. FCC limits for 15.239 are 250uV at 3 meters. You are showing in-band peak and average limit lines between 60-70dBuV at 3 meters. Please correct your radiated data and limits as appropriate for Rule 15.239.
- 6.) Your bandwidth test does not provide any description of how this low power FM transmitter was modulated. According to current interpretations, for this type of device you must test with two audio sources: (1.) playing a "typical" CD or DVD as an audio source, and (2.) using the external analog audio inputs with volume controls turned up to maximum. Please review your test results.
- 7.) The Grantee Code information listed with FCC shows Tony He as the only person authorized to speak on behalf of Everictory Electronics. However, the Confidential Request and Agent Authorization letters are signed by Lixing. Under what authority does Lixing speak on behalf of Everictory Electronics?
- 8.) The 731 form is signed by Iceman. Although I know who Iceman at Audix is, the FCC does not. Kindly provide a legal family and given name for Iceman.
