Dear Sir or Madam:

The application for the above equipment is hereby DISMISSED pursuant to Section 2.917(a) of the Commission's Rules.

The referenced application is filed under 15.517(a) which allows for indoor use only. However, the device may be connected to a laptop/notebook which operates without AC power via battery. Indoor operation cannot be assured in this case.

FCC 47 CFR Section 15.517 (a)(1) states that indoor UWB devices, by the nature of their design, must be capable of operation only indoors. The necessity to operate with a fixed indoor infrastructure, e.g., a transmitter that must be connected to the AC power lines, may be considered sufficient to demonstrate this.

If you elect to refile for equipment authorization you must submit a currently dated and originally signed Form 731, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1103, and all data required by the Rule sections applicable to the equipment. Please be advised that resubmitted applications are not given priority in processing.

You are cautioned that importation and marketing of equipment in the United States bearing the referenced FCC Identifier is prohibited by Section 2.803 of the Rules. Violation of this regulation may subject you to penalties provided in Sections 501 and 502 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.
