Summary

This test report supports a "Limited Modular Approval" certification application of a transmitter operating pursuant to 47 CFR 15.209 and RSS-210. The product is the Aperio V3 iN100. Its operating frequency is 125kHz.

We found that the product met the above requirements without modifications. Steve Morse from ASSA ABLOY Inc. was present during testing. The test sample was received in good condition.

Test Methodology

All testing was performed according to the following rules/procedures/documents; CFR 47 Part 15.209, RSS-210 Issue 8, RSS-Gen Issue 4 and ANSI C63.10-2013. Radiated Emissions were maximized by rotating the device around three orthogonal axes as well as varying the test antenna's height and polarity. The device antenna cannot be maximized separately.

The EUT operating voltage is 9VDC from battery. Fresh batteries were used during testing. The environmental conditions during each test are detailed in the results tables for each section. The following bandwidths were used during radiated spurious and line conducted emissions.


