
Insert the battery with the contacts down, then press firmly until the battery latch clicks twice:





# **Charging Instructions**

The battery pack is not initially fully charged. After installing the battery, charge it with the single slot  $\operatorname{dock}^*$ .





Do not use the Falcon X4 until batteries are charged for minimum 4 hours.

\*. The power supply for the single slot dock is included in the single slot dock box (P/N 94A150057).

#### MicroSD Card Installation

3. Slide the cardholder to the right and then pull it up






 Insert the microSD card with the written part upward. Lock the card into place by pushing the cardholder down and then sliding it to the left.



# **2D Imager Data Capture**






#### **Aiming System Pattern**

- Bluetooth®


To establish a partnership between the Falcon X4 and a host PC, start Windows Mobile® Device Center and follow the steps below:
