The EUT was connected to AC power source through a LISN 1 (Line Impedance Stabilization Network) which provides a 50Ω/50μH + 5Ω linear impedance. 



Figure 1. Below 30MHz



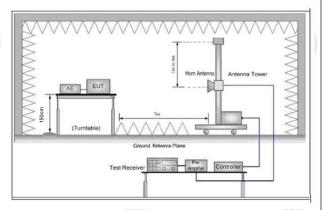


Figure 2. 30MHz to 1GHz
