Request for a change in ID under §2.933 of the FCC rules

4RF, the undersigned, hereby requests a change in ID under §2.933 of the FCC rules.

This change in identification request is for a new FCC ID for a currently approved device. 4RF will establish a new FCC ID under the 4RF Limited grantee code for the purpose of marketing LTE equipment. Sierra Wireless is the original holder with FCC ID: N7NEM7455 and this ID will remain in effect. An authorization letter by Sierra Wireless granting permission for this process is attached as required by the rule.

1. The 4RF grantee code is UIP with FRN 0021732375.
2. A signed permission letter has been received from the original grantee Sierra Wireless giving permission to file the change.
3. 4RF attests that there is no change in the design, circuitry, or construction, and the original test results continue to be representative of and applicable to the equipment. The application of a new grantee code label will be the only cosmetic difference.
