## Install the Software

## IMPORTANT!

If you have any previous version of Bluetooth software already installed, you must uninstall the software before installing the software on the Driver CD.

- **1.** Turn on your computer and insert the Driver CD.
- 2. Double-click the setup.exe file to run the setup program.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to install the Bluesoleil software
- 4. When installation is complete, click Finish.
- 5. You will be asked to restart your computer for configuration changes to take effect, click Yes to restart

## Connect Device

- 1. Plug the adapter into your computer's USB port. The adapter's blue LED flashes when it is ready for use.
- 2. Turn on your device and activate its Bluetooth function making sure it is discoverable (refer to your device's user's quide).
- Open BlueSoleil Space on your computer.

#### Search for Nearby Devices

Double-click on the yellow globe in the center or right-click on it and select Search Devices to search for nearby bluetooth devices. Found device icon(s) appear on the Blue Soleil Space interface

## Pair a Device

Right-click on your device icon and select **Pair**. When pairing is successful, a green connected icon 🔤 appears next to your paired device icon.

#### Note:

- If a password is required when pairing, refer to your device user's quide for details.
- If you are pairing with a smartphone, you are required to enter the same passkey on your phone and on your PC.

#### Search Available Service

- 1. Double-click on the connected device or right-click on it and select Search Service. Services that support your device activates and become selectable at the top of BlueSoleil Space.
- 2. Double-click on activated service icons to establish connection. A dotted line appears between the device icon and yellow globe.

Right-click on the service icons or your device icon for more options.
