To Whom It May Concern:

We, the undersigned, seek exemption in regards to FCC Part 15.19 Labeling Requirements. Our device is compliant however; there is not a practical solution for adhering a sticker with the FCC 15.19 statement to the product as required. The FCC 15.19 statement is printed in the product manual. The FCC ID sticker will be adhered permanently under the battery cover. The unit cannot be operated for the first time without the user being exposed to the sticker. The battery cover must be removed and batteries installed in the unit before initial use. The user will have to install new batteries in the unit for every 8 hours of use. The user will be exposed to the FCC sticker each time the batteries are replaced.
