- Obey all warnings in the Relay Relay™ TBP12 manual.
- Only use non-rechargeable alkaline batteries in the transmitter.
- Do not perform service operations beyond those described in the Relay™ TBP12. Service is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as:
- liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the apparatus
- the unit has been exposed to rain or moisture
- the unit does not operate normally or changes in performance in a significant way the unit is dropped or the enclosure is damaged.
- 4. Do not place near heat sources, such as radiators, heat registers, or appliances which produce heat.
