This letter is to clarify the Professional Installation of the HF3000.

KDB 353028 D01 v01, section A (2) (c) (ii), (iii), and (iv).

A (2) (c) (ii):

The antenna is contained within the shelf of the HF3000. The system requires a communication protocol between the shelf and the cabinet electronics to activate the RF path to that shelf through relays. Other antennas would not be able to understand the protocol and so relays would not be activated.

A (2) (c) (iii):

- (1) This hardware is sold only to hospitals and only through WaveMark sales personnel. It is not available by the internet or any other retail channels.
- (2) This device is <u>not</u> sold via retail to the general public or by mail order. It is only sold by WaveMark and installed by WaveMark personnel.
- (3) This device is <u>not</u> for Consumers and the General Public and is used for Hospitals and Commercial Medical Providers.
- (4) The equipment must be setup to communicate inventory information to the WaveMark cloud computer through the hospital network. For data security purposes, this is only done by our trained installers working with hospital IT personnel.

A(2)(c)(iv):

- (1) The installation is controlled by the Installation Documentation.
- (2) This section is N/A. Installation is performed only by WaveMark personnel.
- (3) Installation requires special training and system communication access via a
- (4) keyboard connected by cable or Bluetooth.
