

1. Boot and shutdown

After long pressing4 seconds for the power button, you can see the boot logo. The system is access into screen locking status after

2. Screen of opening and closing

1. After idling period of time, screen will be automatically closed to save the battery.

2. In the screen opening condition, press the power button, the screen can immediately shutdown. Opening in screen closed condition. If screen is inthe closed position, you canlong press power button to activate the screen. Enter locked condition after opening it, press "lock" icon and slide right for unlocking.

6.2 Date and time
