
Wireless headphones

Construction of the appliance

WIRELESS HEADPHONES

INTENDED USE OF THE APPLIANCE

Wireless headphones for listening to sounds played from external devices (e.g. phone, MP3/MP4 players, tablet, TV, computer) that are connected to the headphones via Bluetooth. When connected to a phone, the headphones also enable you to receive phone calls and make calls to the last number dialled.

The headphones feature a built-in rechargeable battery with a capacity of 300mAh. The set also includes a USB cable (for charging the battery) and a mini-jack cable (for wired

PLEASE NOTE!

Before using the appliance read these instructions carefully and keep them to read again if necessary. The appliance should be used as intended and in accordance with the information contained in the instructions.

SAFETY RULES

- 1. The headphones should not be operated by children or persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacities, or by inexperienced people, or those lacking sufficient knowledge, unless the are using the headphones under supervision or after training
- 2. Prolonged exposure to loud music through headphones may cause hearing loss.
- 3. Do not use headphones while driving, cycling or driving any other vehicles as this may lead to dangerous situations on the road.
- 4. The headphones must be kept at least 10 cm away from cardiac pacemakers and implanted defibrillators. The headphones have built-in magnets producing
- a magnetic field that may interfere with these devices.

 5. Do not expose the headphones to cold, heat or water.

USER'S INSTRUCTIONS

A. CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

- Use only the included USB cable for charging.
- Before using the headphones for the first time,
- charge them without interruption to obtain a full charge.
 During charging, a red LED lights up. This will be lit, even if the headphones are turned off.
- During charging, you can still listen to music and use
- the telephone.

 A full charge takes 1-2 hours
- You can recharge the battery even if it is only partially
- 1. Using the USB cable, connect the headphones and the switched on computer.
- The LED turns red, indicating charging is in progress.The flashing blue LED indicates the headphones battery is fully charged.
- 4. Disconnect the USB cable from the headphones.

B. SWITCHING THE HEADPHONES ON AND OFF

- To turn on the headphones, press and hold the switch headphones for 3 seconds. You will hear a voice message in English "Power on", and the LED will begin to flash
- To turn off the headphones, press and hold the headphones switch for 3 seconds. You will hear a voice message in English "Power off", and the LED will go out.

C. OBTAINING A WIRELESS CONNECTION WITH AN EXTERNAL DEVICE

- 1. Ensure that the external device is equipped with Bluetooth (A2DP profile).
- 2. Turn on the headphones: Press and hold the headphones switch for 3 seconds.

- 3. Run Bluetooth in the external device and allow connection of the headphones (this device being called HP-6007BT).
- 4. Start the audio application in the external device and play the music (or other sounds).
 The sounds will be heard in the headphones.
- Adjust the volume level on the external device.
- Using the buttons on the headphones control panel, adjust the volume, select tracks, receive phone calls, etc.
- To connect the headphones with another external device, first close the Bluetooth connection with the previously connected device and if necessary, turn the headphones off and back on.

D. USING THE BUTTONS OF THE HEADPHONES CONTROL PANEL

Turning the headphones on/off: Press and hold for 3 seconds Playback/pause: Press once briefly

Receive or end a phone call: Press once briefly

Selecting the last dialled telephone number:

Rejecting a phone call:

press and hold for 2 seconds

Select the next/previous track:

press and hold Increase/reduce the volume:

CLEANING

Press once briefly

Do not immerse the headphones in water. Wipe with a damp cloth.
