Disable U-NII-2A and U-NII-2C bands

For U-NII-3 band, the device is applying under 15.407 (b)(4)(ii) and that the emission limits comply with 15.247 (d) for all antenna configurations".

The device complies with antenna gain greater than 10dBi. Please refer to test report FR240223-12AA

The maximum conducted output power (average) remains the same for operation in U-NII-1 band and U-NII-3 band.

There is no change in hardware or in existing RF circuitry.
