Hi Mr. Yang,

Please address following issues.

Q#1: Per FCC KDB 784748 labeling requirement, the FCC ID shall be visible at the time of purchase. Marketing the device without the battery installed when the label is in the battery compartment is acceptable. The FCC ID on the box, or additional documentation directing the user where to find the FCC label, also satisfies this requirement.

Based on current application documents, FCC ID is affixed inside battery compartment but there is no information to guide user to find the FCC ID nor the information state that battery will not be installed during the purchase. Please address how will above requirement be met.

**=> The battery will not be installed to the EUT when placing to market. See attached attestation letter.**

**Q#2: Per the user manual, WLAN and BT can transmit simultaneously but there are no information documented about the co-location issue. Please address.**

**=> WLAN and BT can't transmit at the same time, please see revised user manual.**
