QUICK START

- 1. Insert a SD/HC or MMC memory card into the slot on the right side of the frame
- 2. Power the frame On by pressing the O/J button.
- 3. Automatic picture slideshow will start after a few seconds.

Overview

You new digital picture frame lets you view photos without a computer.

An automatic, continuous slide show lets you enjoy all of you photos with ease.

The built-on stand pulls out to easily stand the frame on any flat surface.

Photos can be viewed directly from memory cards or from the frames's built-in memory.

The frame's built-in rechargeable battery makes it easy to carry the frame with you wherever you go.

Getting Started

To begin using your digital picture frame right away, follow these simple steps.

- Connect the frame to a computer's USB port using the mini USB cable to charge the frame. Once fully charged you can use the frame for up to 2 full hours.
- Once the frame is fully charged insert a memory card (SD/HC or MMC) into the card slot on the side of the frame. Be sure that the logo on the memory is facing you when inserting the card into the slot.
- 3. A slide show will begin automatically . To stop the slide show press \odot \checkmark button twice.

Internal Memory and Memory Card Slot

Your digital picture frame has the capacity to hold up 30 pictures.

The slot marked SD/MMC is meant to be used for your regular memory card, such as the one you use in your camera.

To select form the various types of memory, press 0,∞Jbutton until you see "Select Card" screen. To select the desired memory type use the ◀ or ► button. Press to access the selected memory type.

Thumbnail Screen

This screen shows thumbnail versions of all photos on the selected memory source. Sixr photos are displayed at a time. Use this screen to select a single photo to display, or to start a siide show of all of the photos.

Viewing a single Picture:

- 1. Press ◀ or ► to navigate through your pictures
- 2. Once you have selected a picture of your choice , press 🗮 button
- 3. Your selected picture will display on the screen
- 4. To start slideshow press : button at any time
- 5. To pause the slide show at any time press
- 6. To resume slide show press ≔ button
- 7. To return to the thumbnail view press O_{A} button twice if in slide show mode , If paused press O_{A} button once to return to thumbnail view.

Start Slideshow of Pictures:

- 1. Press and hold 🗮 button
- 2. A sub menu will appear on the bottom left hand corner
- 3. Use ◀ or ► buttons to select "Start Slideshow"
- Press ≡ to start slideshow

Other Options

In the slide show mode, you can press and hold down the button to access the following :Rotate Photo, Zoom Photo, Copy Photo, Delete Photo, Adjust LCD Color. To exit at any time press CJ∠button.

Rotate Photo:

Zoom Photo:

Using the ◀ or ► buttons highlight "Zoom Photo". Press to zoom in and out of the picture displayed on screen. To exit press: (), Jutton.

Copy Photo:

(This option is only available when viewing pictures from memory card) Using the ◀ or ▶ buttons highlight "Copy Photo".Press ≔ to copy the picture on screen to the internal memory. To exit pressO∠J button.

Delete Photo:

(This option is only available when viewing pictures form internal memory) Using the ◀ or ► buttons highlight "Delete Photo". Press ≔ to delete the picture on screen. To exit press ⊘∠ button

Adjust LCD Color:

Using the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright buttons highlight "Adjust LCD Color". Press ≔ to adjust the display. You will have the option to adjust brightness, contrast, tint, and color. Press and hold \lhd or \triangleright buttons to change options from brightness to color, the selected option will be highlighted in blue with a white border, Continuously pressing the \blacktriangleright button will increase the amount and pressing the \blacktriangleleft button will decrease the amount and pressing the \blacktriangleleft button will decrease the amount. Once you have made your adjustments press O_{AJ} button to exit this screen.

Display Settings and Tools

Additional settings will allow you to access the following: **Display image size**, Slideshow transitions, Slideshow Speed, Connect to PC, Power Saving , Factory Default.

Press 0/21 button until you see the 'Select Card' screen. Press and hold == button until the display settingappear.

Use ◀ or ► buttons to highlight your selection. Press 🗮 to make changes, Press ७∠J button to exit a selected option.

Recharging the Frame

Your Digital Picture Frame charges directly from the USB cable. Simply plug your Digital Picture Frame into your computer using your USB Cable. A fully charge takes approximately 2 hours to complete.

The Software is designed to help you find, optimize and transfer picture to your frame or any memory card. The software, residing on your computer, will guide you through 3 Easy Steps:

- 3. Transfer your pictures

The software will help you:

- · View your vertical photos the right way
- · Sharpen your photos
- · Find and transfer photos to your frame
- · Fit more pictures on your frame

Note: To maximize the use of the internal memory on your frame please use software to optimize your pictures before saving to internal memory and or viewing pictures directly from your SD/HC or MMC memory cards.

FAQs

- How to power on / off? To power on press ᠿ∠J button To power off press and hold down ᠿ∠J button for 3 seconds.
- 3. How to copy a single photo from SD card to internal memory? If in thumbnail View press and hold ≡ button until a sub menu appears on the bottom left hand corner. Use the < or ► buttons to select "Copy Photo". Press ≡ button to make the selection. Select "Copy Selected" by pressing ≡ button. "OK " will display when the transfer is completed.
- 4. How to delete photo from internal memory? Choose the photo you want to delete in the internal memory and hold the ≡ button for 3 seconds, release then choose "Delete Photo", then select "Delete Selected ", Finally press ≡ button to confirm delete.

Important Products Safety Instructions

- Always handle the Digital Picture Frame with care.
- Avoid touching the LCD screen. Finger prints may be difficulty to fully remove.
- Always position the Digital Picture Frame on a stable and level surface.. Unstable surface can cause the Digital Picture Frame to topple and fall which will result in possible damage.
- Avoid exposing the Digital Picture Frame to direct sunlight or high temperatures. This may result in damage or shorten life expectance of the frame.
- Do not place it near heat sources such as radiators, heat registers or other appliances that generate heat.
- Orient the Digital Picture Frame away from direct sunlight to reduce glare. Avoid exposing the Digital Picture Frame to rain, water, moisture, or high humidity.
- Do not place it near basins or skins where is may come in contact with water.
- Never place heavy or sharp objects on the LCD panel, frame or USB cord.
- Keep the Digital Picture Frame well ventilated and away from high temperatures to avoid damaging the Digital Picture Frame.

Other Notice and Precautions

Caution:

Never remove the plastic casing. There are no end user serviceable parts inside. Do not attempt repairs your self. The warranty does not cover repairs or attempted repairs by anyone not authorized by the Authorized Dealer. If the frame begins to emit smoke, abnormal noises, or a strange odor, immediately turn it off. Contact the authorized dealer's services center.

Cleaning the Digital Picture Frame

MAKE SURE THE DIGITAL PICTURE FRAME IS TURED OFF

How to clean the screen:

- Wipe the screen with a clean, soft, lint-free cloth. Use the micro fiber protective carrying case to wipe the screen clean. This removes dust and other particles.
- If it is still not clean, apply a small amount of nom-ammonia, non- alcohol based glass cleaner on a clean, soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen.

How to clean the plastic casing:

- 1. Use a soft, dry cloth.
- If it is still not clean, apply a small amount of nom-ammonia, non-alcohol based and mild non-abrasive detergent on a clean, soft, lint-free cloth to clean the surface.

Authorized dealer does not recommend the use of any ammonia or alcohol-based cleaners on the LCD screen or plastic casing, Some chemical cleaners have been reported to damage screen and/or display case.
