



Frequency Response of E-Field (TEM-Cell:ifi110 EXX, Waveguide: R22)




Uncertainty of Frequency Response of E-field: ± 6.3% (k=2)




Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\vartheta = 0^{\circ}$

Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\vartheta = 90^{\circ}$




Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\vartheta = 0^{\circ}$




Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ± 0.5% (k=2)

Receiving Pattern (\phi), \vartheta = 90^{\circ}




Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ± 0.5% (k=2)





Frequency Response of H-Field (TEM-Cell:ifi110 EXX, Waveguide: R22)




Uncertainty of Frequency Response of H-field: ± 6.3% (k=2)




Receiving Pattern (φ), θ = 0°

Receiving Pattern (ϕ), ϑ = 90°




Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\vartheta = 0^{\circ}$




Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ± 0.5% (k=2)

Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\vartheta = 90^{\circ}$




Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ± 0.5% (k=2)
